Mayor's message to the City Council, Salt Lake City, Utah.

My reference to the annual report, of which the following is a copy, read by the City Council at its session last night.

To the President and City Council, Salt Lake City, Utah.

Gentlemen—I have the honor to submit to your consideration my annual report, in which is appended the report of the heads of the several departments.

By reference to the annual report, it appears that the total receipts for the city for the year ending December 31, 1904, amounted to \$7,227,922.22, and the disbursements to \$6,019,119.06.
