WASHINGTON, 17.—During the

trial of the District At-

torney, in delivering his argument,

the prisoner assumed an air of ap-

parent indifference, and devoted

himself to the morning papers,

scanning them hurriedly. The ar-

gument was delivered by Col. Cor-

khill in a very effective manner, fill-

ing the eyes of many in the audi-

ence, but the countenance of the

prisoner remained unchanged. To-

ward the close of the argument, he

had his newspaper laid and leaned

back in his chair, covering his eyes

with his hands, evidently endeavor-

ing to conceal the emotion which he

undoubtedly felt. He then drew a

package of manuscript from his

pocket and commenced writing in a

hurried and nervous manner. The

prisoner's countenance showed in

approval or disapproval of the

statements made in the argument

by Corhill. At one time he inter-

rupted the District Attorney, which

action was called to the attention

of the Court by Judge Porter, of the

counsel for prosecution. Judge Cox

announced that it was within the

power of the Court to try the case

in the absence of the prisoner, and

if he persisted in his turbulent re-

marks, he would cause him to be re-

moved. Galtair, in response, said:

"I will not do it again, your honor,

but I have very deep feelings in this

case." (Laughter.) Mrs. Scoville,

sister of the prisoner, cried bitterly

during the delivery of the argument,

and her little child could be seen

peeping in an affectionate manner

with "Mamma, mamma, what is

the matter?" At the conclusion

of Corhill's argument, there was

long and continued applause.
