WASHINGTON'S VISION.

The first time I ever saw An-
thony Sherman was on the 4th of
July, 1859, on Independence Square.
He was then ninety-one, and be-
coming very feeble; but though so
old, his piercing eyes reflected as
he looked in Independence Hall,
which, he said, he had come to
gaze upon once more before he was
gathered home.
"What time is it?" said he, rais-
ing his trembling eyes to the clock
in the steeple, and endeavoring to
shade the former with a shaking
hand, "what time is it? I can't
see well and I am used to it."
"Half-past three," he continued, "let
us go into the hall; I want to tell
you an incident of Washington's
life—one which no one knows
of except myself, and if you live,
you will before long, see it verified.
Mark me, I am not superstitious,
but you will see it verified."
Reaching the "Warrior's" room, in
which the sacred relics of our early
days are preserved, we sat down on
one of the old-fashioned wooden
benches, and my venerable friend
related to me the following singular
incident, which, from the pecu-
liarity of our national affairs at the
present time, I have been induced
to give to the world. I give it, as
nearly as possible, in his own
words.
"When the bold action of our
Congress, in admitting the independ-
ence of the colonies, became known
to the world, we were
laughed and scoffed at as silly, pre-
sumptuous rebels, whom British
troops would soon tame into
submission; but undauntedly we
prepared to make good what we had
said. The next encounter came,
and the result was the result. It is
easy and pleasant for those of the
present generation to talk and
write of the days of '76, but they
little know—neither can they im-
agine—the trials and sufferings of
those who lived through them. I
can only say, however, that, in my
opinion, the most glorious and
valuable thing that our country has
yet done, is that the American people
do not properly appreciate the boon
of freedom. Early spirit is yearly
becoming more and more extinct,
and until it is checked, will, at no
distant day, undermine and tumble
into ruin the noble structure of the
Republic. But let me hasten to my
narrative.
"On the opening of the Revolution
we experienced all phases of
fortune—new good and now ill, at
one time victorious, and at another
conquered. The darkest period we
had, however, I think, when
Washington, after several reverses,
retreated to Valley Forge, where he
resolved to pass the winter of '77.
After passing the hardest time, the
winter of '77, he came down the
country, and his old com-
mander's care-worn cheeks as he
would be conversing with a con-
fidential officer about the condition
of his poor soldiers. You have
doubtless heard the story of Wash-
ington going to the theatre to pray.
Well, it is not only true, but he
used often to pray in secret for the
aid and comfort from that God, the in-
crease of whose providence
alone brought us safely through
those dark days of tribulation.
"One day, I remember it well—
the chilly wind whistled and howl-
ing, and the leaves were blown through
the sky was cloudless and the sun
shining brightly—he remained in
his quarters nearly the whole of the
forenoon, alone. When he came
out, I noticed that his face was a
shade paler than usual, and that
there seemed to be something on
his mind of more than ordinary im-
portance. Returning just after dusk
he appeared in the orderly to the
quarters of the adjutant, a young
man who was present in attendance.
After a preliminary conversation,
which lasted some half an hour,
Washington, gazing upon his com-
panion with that strange look of
dignity, which he alone could com-
mand, said to the latter:
"I do not know whether it was
owing to the anxiety of mind, or
whether but this was the result of
sitting at this very table, engaged
in preparing a dispatch, something
in the apartment seemed to disturb
me. Looking up, I beheld stand-
ing exactly opposite me, a young
man, of the age of the adjutant, and
of a most beautiful form. So astonish-
ed was I that I had given strict or-
ders not to be disturbed—that it
was some moments before I found
language to inquire the cause of
his presence. A second, third, and
even a fourth time I repeated the
question, but received no answer
from my mysterious visitor other
than a slight raising of his eyes.
By this time I felt a strange sen-
sation spreading through me. I
would have risen, but the riveted
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
