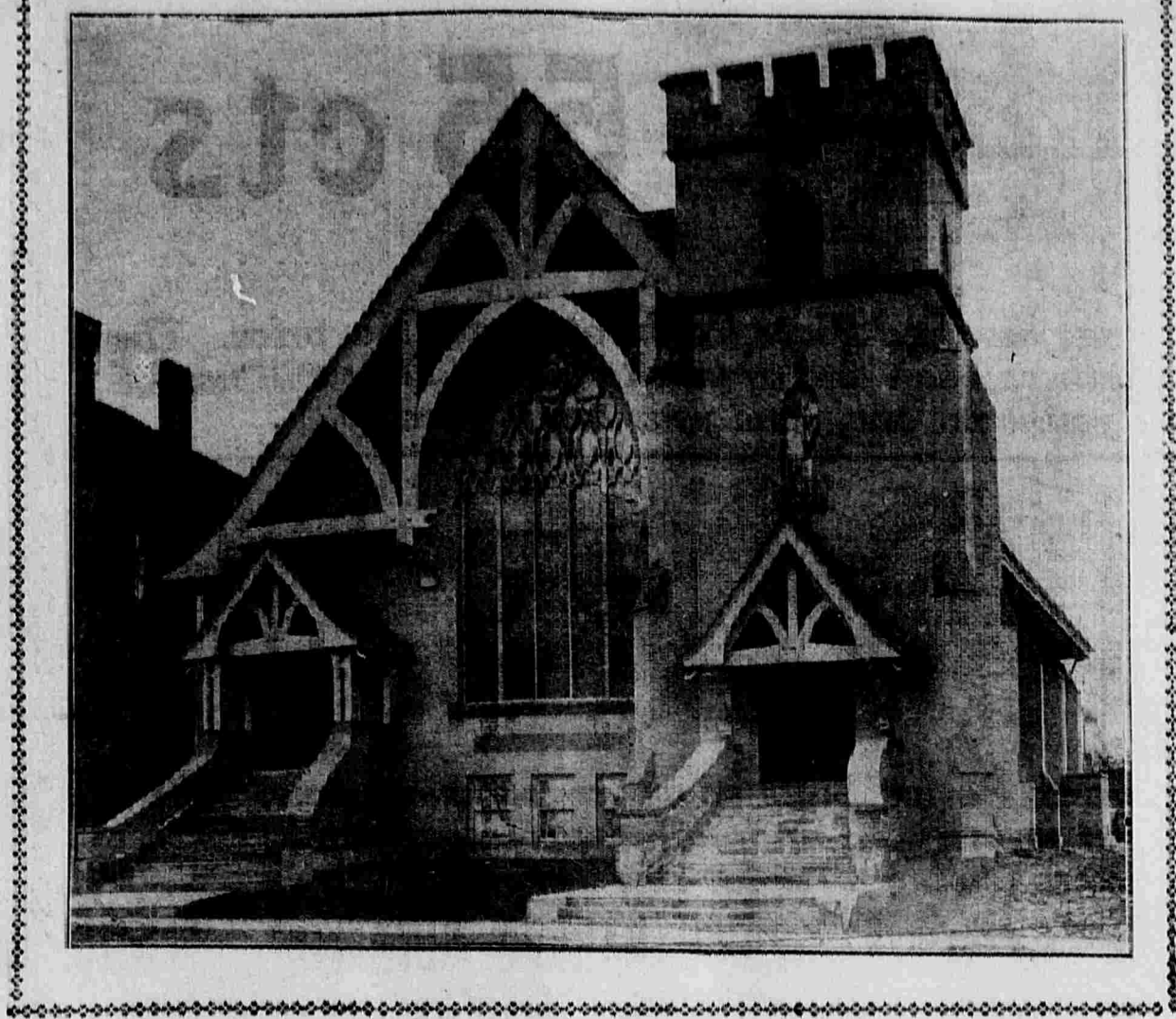


Dedication of New Seventeenth Ward Chapel.

Important Event to be Publicly Commemorated in Impressive Manner Tomorrow Afternoon—Building Has Been Fifteen Months in Course of Construction and Cost \$26,000, All of Which Has Been Paid.

An event of much interest to the people of the Seventeenth ecclesiastical ward, this city, will be the dedicatory and opening services of the new chapel, just completed. The exercises will begin at 1 o'clock tomorrow (Sunday afternoon), and will be continued at 7 p. m. of the same day and at 7:30 Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings of next week. For each meeting an unusually attractive program has been prepared, and the occasions are expected to be epochs in the history of the ward.

The chapel is on First North street, midway between West Temple and First West. From points of beauty of architecture, solidity, and thoroughness of finish, as well as in the matter of convenience, the building is perhaps without a peer in the Church. A brief statement concerning the structure follows:

A bequest of \$10,000, by Mrs. Mathilda M. Barratt, in 1902, gave impetus to the building of the chapel. The site was purchased in 1902, at a cost of \$2,750. The corner stone was laid December 4, 1902, by Bishop Walter A. Neale. Building completed under direction of his successor, Bishop Franklin S. Tinsley, at a cost of about \$26,000, the main hall is 100 feet long, with a seating capacity of 500. The basement contains seven class rooms, and a fire-proof vault for ward records. The art window, representing the "First Vision," was presented by Mrs. Annie D. Watson. The supervising architects were Ware & Tregonia. From the laying of the corner stone to the completion of the edifice only about 15 months elapsed, and it is entirely free from debt or incumbrance of any kind whatsoever. Provision has been made for the holding of a tower, which will be undertaken when financial conditions will permit.

Each room of the chapel is provided with call bells, and there are especially beneficial in the class rooms of the basement. The whole edifice is self-ventilating, fresh air being supplied throughout the raising or lowering of a single window, and all in all the latest

ideas in design and execution have been carried into effect in the structure.

To avoid the overcrowding of the services at the various meetings scheduled for the opening of the chapel, on Sunday morning the children of the Sunday school will be conducted through the building, and will be permitted to thoroughly inspect the interior.
