GOVERNOR'S VETOES UPHELD.

FORT CARSON IS A SICK SITE Ridden—After Being Re-entered—
Tumultuous Changes Had to Be Made.

After reading the journal this morning the President of the State declared that the House had made many changes in the session bill, and so spent action should be taken to have the matter considered, when it would take a whole day to engross the bill. It was suggested that a conference committee be appointed upon matters of disagreement between the two houses, and a committee as special consider the changes.

One Miller called attention to the fact that the appropriation bill was also delayed in the House, and the Senate was asked to make some changes in the bill to give it time for consideration.

The author of the bill could be learned what the House intended was.

A communication was received from the House, announcing the passage of H. B. 44, relating to the disposal of state lands.

The committee on appropriations and finance reported H. B. 44, April 12, after the bill had been referred to the office of auditor of state, and measures, without recommendation.

TRANSMISSION OF EXPENSES.

The committee on appropriations and finance reported an estimate petition of \$5,000 for the expenses of the Trans Mississippi congress to be held in San Luis City on April 1st, 1868, for the purpose of transmitting the bill to Congress.

The committee thought the bill should be transmitted by the Senate.
