## Bounty Resolution Debated.

Richards Thought He Saw a Suspi-  
cious Circumstance—Joseph's  
Mining Bill.

There in the house yesterday afternoon centered on the adoption of H. R. No. 1, as amended by the senate. The resolution in its original form was in the nature of a request to county clerks to discontinue the issuance of bounty certificates pending an investigation on bounty frauds. The senate strengthened the resolution by making the investigation more extensive than originally provided for, and in this form it was returned to the house for its action. Despite the fact that the amendments made no particular alteration in the measure, there were those in the house who were slow to accept it in its amended state, fearing, no doubt, that the wisdom of the wise had been brought to bear in order to defeat the end sought to be attained. Mr. Kuehler, chairman of the joint committee, appealed to his colleagues to concur in the amendments of the senate, as they would do no wise interfere with what was desired to be brought about. Others supported him and wanted the resolution placed upon its final passage. Thompson, who had previously made a motion to defer action pending the printing of the resolution, withdrew the same, whereupon Joseph asked that Mr. Richards tell the house what he had told him a few seconds before, as he believed it would throw a little light on the subject. Responding to Mr. Richards' question, he was in the senate when the measure was passed by a bare majority, and he had heard a senator say that the resolution was amended to suit the needs of the house, a circumstance which he regarded as suspicious, to say the least.

After further debate the roll was called on a motion to concur. Mr. Richards being the only member to dissent, Joseph wanted to be excused from voting, but Mr. Fishburn insisted and he voted "yes." The resolution was referred to the committee on enrolling and engrossing.

## SPECIAL ORDERS.

H. R. 42 by Wootton, increasing the powers of city councils, was brought up for final passage, but on motion of Edward the rule was made. The special order for Tuesday next at 3 p. m., so as to permit of further amendments if any such were deemed necessary. The resolution amending the constitution abolishing the taxation of mortgages, was made the special order for Thursday, Jan. 26, at 3 p. m. On motion the sergeant-at-arms was instructed to furnish each member of the house with printed slips of the amendments to the constitution, and those proposed to printed bills.

A second communication from the governor notified the house that the world's fair deficit of \$10,000 should have been listed among the unauthorized deficits, and after considerable discussion as to how to do it, the line was moved up a notch and the matter fixed.

## NEW HOUSE BILLS.

The bills introduced during the afternoon session of which were given in last night's "News," are as follows:

H. B. 55—Austin, creating a board of park commissioners to control and maintain state parks. Public lands.

H. B. No. 60—Kuehler, providing for a central experiment station in connection with the experiment farm in southern Utah. Agriculture and horticulture.

H. B. No. 61—Carroll, authorizing registration agents to register voters under certain conditions. Elections.

H. B. No. 62—Roberts, altering the constitution of the state board of land commissioners and providing for public lands.

H. B. No. 63—Joseph, providing right-of-way for drainage tunnels without condemnation proceedings. Mines and mining.

H. B. No. 64—Dadley, requiring certain bonds from school trustees. Education.

H. B. No. 65—McCreary, requiring plain, tender a fee of \$3 to the garnishee in supplementary garnishment proceedings. Judiciary.

H. B. No. 66—Richards, providing for the publication of the proceedings of the legislature and county commissioners in newspapers. Public printing.

H. J. M. No. 4—Austin, requesting the president and Congress of the United States to set apart the Strawberry valley in the Utah reservation as a state park.

Mr. Joseph's bill gives the owner of mining ground the legal right to run a drainage tunnel through ground belonging to others without condemnation proceedings. It is provided, however, that the tunnel shall not follow any ledge or vein and shall be open to the owner of the claim at all times.

It was suggested that the Legislature be petitioned to come to the relief of the creditors, by making an appropriation in their behalf, but this plan was shown to be not feasible, by the fact that the Legislature had no such power. To petition the First Presidency of the Church in relation to the matter presented to Bishop Preston was also advocated by some of those present, but this idea was deferred until after the presiding bishopric had made a formal answer.

A meeting will be held by the creditors next Tuesday, when the committee appointed to secure legal counsel will report.

Mr. Doremus said: "The situation is this. The only assurance the reclamation service officers have that the land owners here desire to have the water supply increased for their lands is that given by the arid land reclamation commission of the state of Utah. Moreover, the situation here is different from that which obtains in other states in that the lands to be irrigated are all in private ownership, and the individual owners are not in a position to proceed and provide water desired or needed, without the assent of the land owners. The government engineers have prosecuted their investigations as far as is consistent before they have this assurance from the land owners; and the only way for those owners to express their desire in the matter is to subscribe to the articles of association prepared for that purpose, and which describes the land for which water supply is needed."

Information for Government.

"This places the government in possession of definite information as to the individual owners of the land, and the quantity of water necessary. The only danger in the matter is that before the people express themselves in this manner, the government will have done all the preparatory work to be done, and the engineers and men will be scattered in other parts of the country to be engaged in the same class of work for other states. Their preliminary work is now done for the season, and the representatives have been called in. The spring season is approaching, and when the time comes for them to take the field again, if the Utah land owners have not taken united action in formal expression, these representatives of the government are likely to be sent elsewhere, and getting them back here would be a serious question, particularly considering the activity evident in other states in the matter of securing government assistance."

SCATTERED FAR AND WIDE.

"One great difficulty in securing a united expression of opinion is the fact that the land owners are scattered, and it is the hardest thing in the world to get them all together. The state and land commission has recommended the Legislature to provide for paid canvassers who shall visit land owners with books containing the articles of association, and to be filled out with

their names, the number of shares they take, the number of acres they own, and a description of the latter. The books are now all prepared, and can be circulated without delay and rapidly, so that in a short time, long before the field forces of the government are ready for active service again, the articles can be signed by land owners in large tracts of country to be irrigated, so that the government can begin on these tracts while yet others are being signed up. This matter of canvassers should be pushed with the Legislature, that no time be lost."

PROF. SWENDSON TALKS.

Prof. G. L. Swenson, the head of the government reclamation service in this city, when asked for his views, replied that Engineer Doremus seemed to have covered the case pretty fully, and all he cared to say was that some expression of opinion from the people as an organized whole was due the government.
