

MINING, BUSINESS AND STOCKS.

TECOPA COMPANY IS PLANNING SMELTER

Southern Utah Ores to be Treated at New Plant—Will Care for Six Hundred Tons a Day.

The Tecopa Mining company of Nevada is arranging for the early construction of a four-furnace lead-silver smelter with a capacity of 600 tons a day to treat its own and custom ores, and unless the unforeseen interferences construction work will be commenced within a few weeks. The big plant will be one of the largest smelters in the entire southwest part of the state, and will be located at Tecopa. A 15-mile railway will be built from the plant to connect with the Gunsight and Noonday mines. Large bodies of ore have been developed at depth in the Tecopa mines, the recent uncovering of the Gunsight vein proving the persistent nature of the bodies of silver-lead ores.

With the erection of the smelter the company will be in a position to handle all the ore produced, while a large quantity of the silicious ores of Goldfield, Pioche and other Nevada districts will also be treated. The fluxing Nevada ores will prove exceptionally valuable to treat in conjunction with the white lead-silver ores of the Tecopa people to undertake the construction of their own plant.

STOCKS SHOW IMPROVEMENT.

Salt Lake Exchange Develops Better Market—Prices Remain About Same.

Conditions on the Salt Lake exchange this morning showed considerable improvement over yesterday and the volume of business was far in excess of the previous day. The public was in the market today with considerable money and the trading was not altogether profitable.

All stocks on the board at the present time are remarkably low, undoubtedly due to conditions in the east. Persons who have been in the east for several months declare that interest in mining is just being revived and that with the lack of money in the west, mining stock markets are naturally slow. Utah, with its varied mining districts, is apparently better off than many of the states.

Columbus Consolidated showed considerable improvement today. The bearish movement was undoubtedly due to the story that was circulated that the end of the high grade at the property was in sight. This has been proved to be positively untrue and that shipping, if anything, is now heavier than ever.

Bullock was hit the hardest of any stock today and sold at 3 1/2 cents. Iron Blossom was again a heavy seller.

The number of shares of stock sold today was 62,780, while the amount represented was \$4,874.07.

On the curb market there was considerable activity and a large array of stocks was sold. Mammoth changed hands at \$1.70, while old American sold for 15 cents.
