The work of rescuing and transporting wounded and homeless survivors is attended with the great confusion. The task of digging out and burying the dead, at both Messina and Reggio, has been abandoned. During the first few days such bodies as were recovered were laid out in long rows for possible identification, but as there were very few cases where any of the dead were recognized, they are now being covered with quick line when this material is available. 

Stuart K. Lupton, American vice-consul at Messina, arrived one week before the earthquake. He was stopping at the Hotel Victoria, which was half destroyed. After satisfying himself that A. S. Cheney, the American consul at Messina, and his wife, were buried in the ruins of their consulate, Mr. Lupton took up headquarters on board the warships in the harbor.

Maj. J. E. Reynolds Landis, the American military attache at Rome, who was sent here with vice Consul Cutting and the interpreter of the embassy. Winthrop Chaplain, has organized a force of 60 soldiers at work on the ruins of the American consulate under which are the bodies of Comsul Arthur S. Cheney and his wife. Rome, Jan. 4.—The universal brotherhoop spoken of by Archbishop Ireland, of St. Paul, was further emphasized in Rome today when, upon the arrival of 1,500 wounded from Messina and Reggio. Mayor Nathan telephoned the vatican asking whether these unfortunates could be taken in there. The vatican replied in the affirmative, and the wounded were received with open arms. To realize fully what this incident signifies, it must be explained that Signor Nathan is not a Catholic and that he was at one time grand master of the Masons.

The first 126 of the wounded sent to the vatican were received at the station by Monsignor Misitally, sent by the pope.

Port Said, Jan. 4.—The American supply ships Culgoa and the scout cruiser Yankton arrived here this afternoon, after a smooth trip through the canal from Suez.

The Culgoa, loaded with provisions, sailed this afternoon at 5 o'clock for Messina where she is expected to arrive Friday next. The Yankton also will proceed to Messina immediately after the arrival of the flagship squadron now coming through.

**NEW YORK 80 CENT GAS** LAW CONSTITUTIONAL

Washington, Jan. 4.-The supreme ours of the United States today reversed the decision of the United States

versed the decision of the United States court for the southern district of New York in the various cases against the Consolidated Gas company of New York City. The cases involved the validity of the New York state laws of 1995 and 1995, the latter of which fixed the pelce of gas in New York City at 38 cents per 1,000 cubic feet.

The action was begin by the gas company in the circuit court in the shape of a prayer for an injunction against the enforcement of the law and the injunction was granted by that court on the ground that the isrues of the law make it confiscatory of the property of the gas company, the rate fixed being below a reasonable price, in the opinion of that court. Justice Peckhum delivered the opinion today overraing the lower court. The effect of the decision is to declare the law constitutional
