Be it enacted by the Governor and egislative Assembly of the Terriry of Utah: That section one of "An Act amending certain secherein named, for the preseration of game, Approved Feb. 22, 78, is hereby amended by striking in the ninth and tenth lines the "March" and "September" inserting in lieu thereof the words "April" and "August." Secon two of said act is hereby amended by striking out the word "Janutherefor the words "December in each year," and after the word "August" insert the word "following" and strike out the words "in each year" in the fourth line. Section three of said act is hereby amended by striking out the words "said commissioner" in the sixth and seventh lines and inserting in lieu thereof the words "the inform-

SEC. 2. Section two of "An Act to repeal section twenty-one hundred and ninety-six (2196) and section A twenty-one hundred and ninetyseven (2197) of the Compiled Laws of Utah, and prescribing the time and mode of taking fish out of the public waters, approved February 22, 1878," is hereby amended by inserting in the fifth line after the word "traps" the words "set lines."

dred and ninety-eight (2198) of the Compiled Laws of Utah is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor: "Every person who puts into the waters of this Territory any poisonous or explosive substance, or anything that is injurious to fish or that renders the water un- HARDWARE, fit for household purposes, is guilty of a misdemeanor."

SEC. 4. That any person, corporation or association, who has or may hereafter take out the waters of any WM. contain fish, shall be required to place above the headgate, near the point from where the water is diverted from such stream or lake, a screen made of wire or other suitable material, the meshes not to exceed one and a quarter inches square, and to keep the same in good
