First wash the sore well with strong soap suds, then drop eight or ten drops of the acid in it twice a day, until it has the appearance of a fresh wound; after which, it should be washed clean with suds made from castile soap, and left to heal, which it will quickly do if the acid has been used long enough; but if it does not get well, apply the acid again, until it does cure, for it is a sure remedy, and will not fail, if it is applied until the diseased flesh is all burnt out .- [Prairie Farmer.






