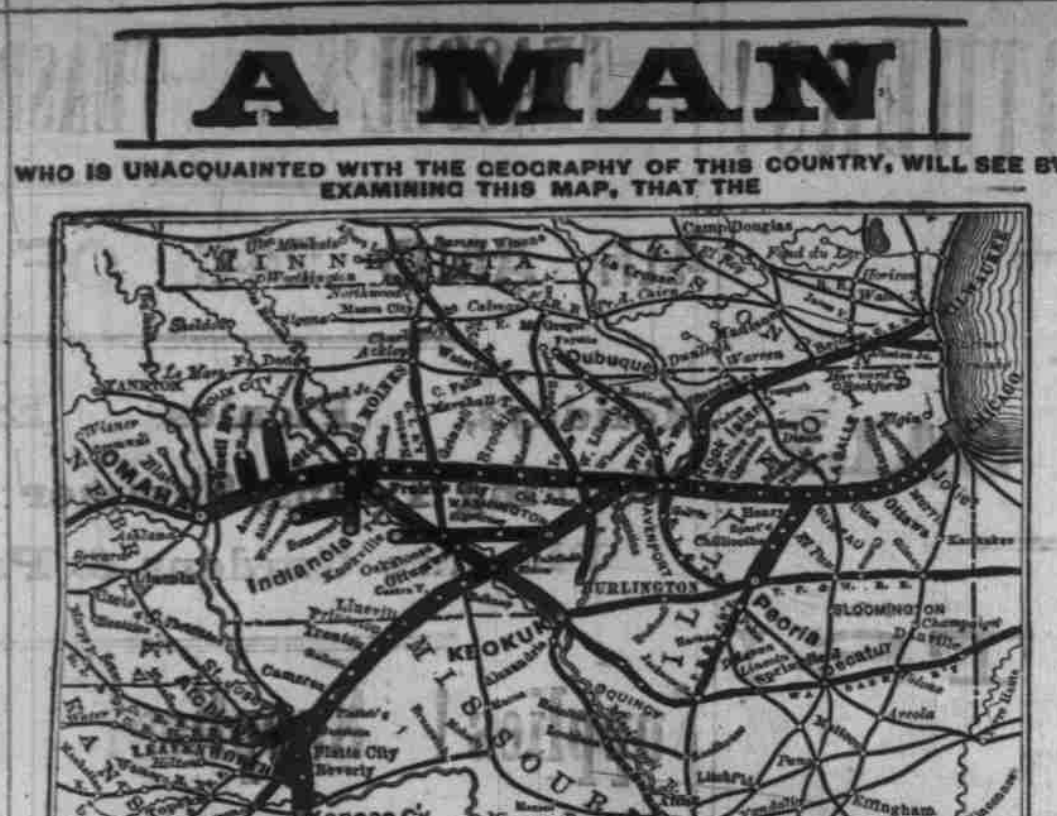

Editors Deseret News:

There are only seven families in this little valley, and two in the adjoining one, about six miles distant. Four of the families are from Utah, and have been here for many years, and have been blessed with good health in the valley. The season, as elsewhere, has been extremely dry, and consequently water and grass have been very scarce. The brethren commenced a reservoir last Spring, but for want of sufficient help did not finish it in time, and lost a great amount of water that might otherwise have been saved. We are looking for more. Quite a number of Navajos have been baptized since the mission first began here, and as a rule they feel well.

We have with us the last week been favored with visit from the President of the Stake, Jesse N. Smith, accompanied by Bishop John Hunt, both of whom have been here for some time. They held three meetings, two here and one at Brother Tenney's. Two of our Lamantite brethren were present at the meetings, and spoke a few moments, expressing their regret at the carelessness of some of the tribe, and saying there was plenty of water everywhere here, and that they would again be the same, if the people would repent and not follow the example of "bad Americans," as he termed some of the tribe.
