Congress' Committee Not to be Annoyed Till Next Month.

**SENATOR PEPPER'S MONEY PLANS.**

Vote's Bill for the Cigar of Silver Ballot in the Treasury.—The House Debate.

**WASHINGTON, Aug. 14.—**President members of the House are now coming to the conclusion that there is little chance of the committee being announced before the beginning of September; when the silver question is disposed of. This story circulated Saturday to the effect that Secretary Carlisle had stated that Wilson of West Virginia would succeed Springer as chairman of the ways and means committee. He is much annoyed by a report which has been published. Senator Butler of South Carolina today introduced a bill repealing the state bank tax.

Speaker of House introduced a bill for the release of three hundred million dollars of that money extantable for government bonds.

The Republican cause was postponed, owing to the absence of the Senate adjournment.

### IN CONGRESS.

Last Night's Proceedings in the Two Houses.

**WASHINGTON, Aug. 14.—**Michael (Mike) of Oregon gave notice of an amendment to the bill for the release of capital to maintain the parity of gold and silver. The amendment, after a long preamble, declared it the sense of Congress that no change be made in the law now existing during the Fifty-third Congress.

Mr. Johnson (Dems.) of Missouri introduced a bill for the setting of the silver button in the treasury, saying it was sent to him from San Fran, and not the capital at all. It provided for setting aside in coin one billion as a reserve such amount of silver button purchased under the act of July, 1890, as shall equal at its current value the aggregate of all the treasury notes held by the nation, so that the number of the surplus bullion to be coined in silver dollars, and such dollars to be used for the redemption of silver certificates now issued by law, provided that shall not exceed the amount provided by law.

The second provision provides that the national banking associations be entitled to receive circulating notes of the value of one-half of the United States currency, not, however, to exceed the amount of capital stock actually paid in.

London, Aug. 14.—In the commons today Robert Lowe said the future, in view of the fall of the free exchange of silver at a rate of 24 to 1, introduced in the Senate of the United States, to declare that the time was opportune for Great Britain to allow the United States to establish a favorable parity for gold and silver.
