SUNDAY MORNING FIRE. Duke's First South Street Millinery Establishment Damaged to the Amount of \$7000.

At a few minutes past 1 o'clock yesterday morning the spacious millinery parlors of J. J. Duke on First South Street, just west of the clock tower, were burned in flames, the origin of which up to the present are completely shrouded in mystery.

The fire started in the rear of the store and owing to the inflammable character of the material spread with such rapidity that a loss of \$7000 with only \$2000 insurance received is a remarkably small sum.
