CHICAGO, 26.—Building the past year was never exceeded, except in 1879, the year succeeding the great fire; even then the amount of rebuilding was only twice as great as the past year, and the amount of ground covered by new structures was less than twice as great. Three thousand six hundred and thirty building permits have been issued; frontage of new structures, lineal measure 14 miles; total cost of buildings erected on permits, \$17,500,000; total probably, \$20,000,000. Suburban towns show equal growth, and the building prosperity and character of the edifices has generally improved.

BELLAIRE, Ohio, 26.—The Republicans of the seventeenth Congressional district have nominated Col. J. D. Taylor of Cambridge for the vacancy in Congress caused by the death of J. T. Updegraff.

JACKSON, Miss., 26.—In the mandamus case brought by Gen. J. R. Chalmers against the Secretary of State, to compel him to count for Chalmers the Tate county vote returned for J. R. Chambliss, counsel for the Secretary of State filed a plea in abatement, on the ground of a former suit pending in the same cause of action. Counsel for Chalmers demurred. Judge Wharton overruled the demurrer, and the case was dismissed.

INDIANAPOLIS, 26.—The democratic committee of the ninth Congressional district nominates Judge Ward, Congressman elect, to fill the vacancy occasioned by the death of G. S. Orth.
