## BOSTON SUNSHINE HAS ANOTHER GOLD BRICK

Clean Up for Month of May Shows \$13,000 Secured in Treating Less Than 4,000 Tons.

Manager George H. Dorn of the Boston Sunshine property at Mercur came into the city last night with a \$13,000 gold brick packed away, as a result of a clean up at the mill for the month of May. The brick when assayed will run in excess of \$13,000 it is believed. This represents the treatment of less than 4,000 tons of ore at the new mill. This morning John Dorn was proudly exhibiting the 4,000 tons of ore, now consigned to a gold brick to the members of the Salt Lake exchange.

After depositing the brick with the United States assay office this morning, Mr. Dorn returned to Mercur. The management of the Boston Sunshine property feels quite enthusiastic over the results of the clean up as it demonstrates that the new plant is working out in an ideal manner. A saving in excess of \$25 a ton is being made and it means that a comfortable life is being led aside each month by the company.

Another property in the Mercur district that will probably be heard from in the near future is the Sacramento. It is understood that Manager Hunt, who is in charge of the plant that has been erected by leasers to treat the tailings of the Sacramento dumps, will be ready to start things moving by the end of the week. By the plant that is now nearly ready, it is expected that a good profit may be wrung from the old dumps.

### STOCK TRADING IMPROVES.

#### Market Puts on a More Active Appearance—Securities Still Going Lower.

Conditions on the mining exchanges this morning showed a decided improvement over yesterday, although there was a general tendency to sag. There were no indications of the market improving in price or volume of business.

On the Salt Lake exchange the number of shares sold this morning amounted to 52,390, with the amount represented was \$3,643.25. On the Utah exchange the number of shares of stock sold was 14,500 and the amount represented by the transactions was \$6,468.

On the Salt Lake exchange 1,000 shares of Sacramento found their way into the market. This was sold at 2 1/2 cents. It is understood that the leasers on the property will begin treating the tailings within the next few days and it is expected that the company will shortly receive a revenue that will somewhat revive it. Carls, which has been chasing after a stock for some time, was down to 96 cents this morning. Iron Blossom was ill at ease today and sold as low as \$1.75. Ohio Copper continues to get bumped and reached a new low level of \$4.55. The eastern market will probably endeavor to send this stock to \$3. Utah Consolidated started down this morning and the highest price that was paid was 20 cents.

On the curb market the Salt Lake exchange Piche King received a new high bid. It was 37 cents and it was offered at 40 cents. During the session 3,000 shares of the Piche King crossed the rail at 9 cents. Bingham Central Standard sold for 24 cents.

### SEND REPORT ON INSPIRATION.

Stockholders of Inspiration Copper company have received the following from the company: "The Development of the Inspiration Copper company properties at Globe, Arizona, is progressing very satisfactorily. This development began during the month of January, 1909, and most of that month was devoted to preparatory work. "In what is known as the Joe Bush shaft—located about 800 feet west of the Miami side line—we have an ore body with good values extending from the 100-foot depth to the 205-foot depth, the sulphides of which average 2.64 per cent copper; from the 100 to the 112-foot depth the ore consists of sulphides and carbonates and averages 3.72 per cent copper; the balance of the ore body is all sulphides. These 105 feet of ore have been developed since May 1, and it is proposed as it is possible to keep up rapid development."

### LOOKING FOR SMELTER SITE.

The International Smelting & Refining company which is building a smelter in the Pine Canyon, Tooele county, is not content with its already many acquisitions in the ore treatment line, but is now after a smelter site in Arizona. It is believed that the company is looking for a site where there are bodies that are now being developed there make room for another smelter. There has been a rumor for some time that the Copper Range company, which is now in the process of developing a smelter in the United States, is looking for a site in Arizona. It is understood that the company intends to break away as did the Utah Copper company, and sell its property in the United States. Although the story has been denied by President Paine, there is considerable possibility of something of the kind happening. With a few more acquisitions, the International Smelting & Refining company could get a large slice of the Arizona ores.

### ARE DEVELOPING TONNAGE.

Ernest R. Woolley has returned from a trip to the Woodley mine, where he and a number of other Salt Lake miners are interested. He asserts that the company is looking out for the great milling ore and that conditions are improving. "We will develop the property for tonnage before putting in a mill," declared Mr. Woolley. "The property is one place we have now developed a 14-foot vein of good milling ore and in another place we have opened up a parcel vein which is nine feet across. We have all our own timber and water power."

### OPTION ON MARBLE.

Salt Lake's Secure Quarry in Logan Canyon and Will Begin Operations. After having been idle for several months and not being able to interest capital in the project, the Utah Marble company of Director of the quarry on all its holdings in Logan Canyon to A. G. Liebman and G. W. Purvis of Salt Lake City. The option expires for six months and will be operated jointly with the big black marble property now held by the same men at Pelican Point to the west of Utah Lake.

At a meeting of the stockholders of the Utah Marble company Wednesday night the sale of the company was ratified, so that all that now remains to be done is the payment of the money. The purchasers of the property intend to develop the quarry. They are of the opinion that the marble is of equally as good grade as many of the eastern white marbles and the quarry has been known for some time, but owing to the lack of interest taken in it by people with the means to push it through, it has remained idle. Work will commence on it at once.

### WILL DECIDE DEAL TODAY.

With President W. V. Rice and Secretary W. H. Clark of the Nevada Hills Copper company, the Salt Lake City office is considering the offer of the Nevada Hills property to George Wingfield and associates or its consolidation with the Nevada Hills property. It is understood that the recent option expires today. While in New York recently Mr. Wingfield emphatically declared that he would not take up the option without the time limit. He asserted that if the time was extended so that he could clean up a few points (which he was uncertain about, he declared he might go ahead with the deal. J. R. Davis, one of the directors of the Nevada Hills is a resident of Goldfield and is there with the officials. It is said that some understanding will be reached today.

### DELAYED IN ORE SHIPMENTS.

Columbia Consolidated Will Be Shipping at Usual Rate by Monday. Lack of timbers with which to care for the work in the mill at the Columbia Consolidated has caused a further delay in the shipping of ore from the mine. General Manager Tony Jacobson declares that by Monday the company will again be shipping ore at the usual rate.
