**Last Night's Dispatches.**  
**WESTERN.**  
U. S. V. C. F. Railway.  
SAN FRANCISCO, 15. In the suit brought by the United States to recover from the Central Pacific Railroad Company 5 per cent. of the net earnings of the road from July 15th, 1869, in repayment of the Government subsidy and interest, Judge Sawyer, of the United States Circuit Court, to-day, rendered a decision for the defendant, holding that the obligation to pay did not take effect until October 1st, 1874, when the road was finally accepted by the Government.  
**FOREIGN.**  
**GREAT BRITAIN.**  
The French Election returns. LONDON, 15. A dispatch dated Paris, midnight, gives the latest returns, showing 325 republicans and 191 conservatives are elected, and that some Bonapartist leaders, such as Duke de Mouchy, M. Chevreux, and M. Raoul Duval, have been defeated. The elections are considered as unsatisfactory in result, and are calculated to lead to a renewal of the strife.  
The *France*, Duke de Broglie's organ, claims that after Gambetta's death the 400 republican majority is virtually a Government victory, which encouraged the conservatives to continue in the policy inaugurated on the 16th of May.  
The *Defense*, clerical, considers the reduction of the republican majority a rebuke to the insolence of the 583, and an encouragement to President McMahon to persevere in his present course.  
The *Temps*, while admitting a reduction of the republican majority, considers the election of Gambetta in favor of republicans peremptory, and declares that it will be neither possible or permissible to resist it.  
The *Constitution* advises the immediate retirement of the minister.  
**Eastern War News.**  
The Hungarian invasion of Roumania is positively declared a hoax.  
The Roumanians assert that the deserters from Plevna report Osman Pasha's army destitute of clothing and ammunition, and actually provisioned. The men and officers are tired of fighting and suffering, and are disposed to surrender. Russian and Turkish advisers indicate that the Russians occupied Yaguli, Sarabon, and Kiril Tepe, abandoned by Mukhtar Pasha, and are maneuvering for an advantageous position from which to make an attack on the Turkish lines concentrated about Aladja Dag.  
A correspondent at Slatova gives a favorable account of Russian preparations for the winter campaign. At Slatova, the Russian army has been laid in at the lower part of the railroad. Two miles south of Simniza bridge it takes eight hours, and twenty men pushing behind, to get a light wagon through. The railway from Plevna to Simniza is progressing rapidly.  
A special from Therapia states that the Russians attacked Lulima and destroyed part of the town, but were beaten off.  
A correspondent at Cettinge reports that the bulk of Montenegrins have been dismissed to sow crops.  
Chevket Pasha telegraphed on Sunday that he had arrived at Lankoviza from Plevna, and would continue his march to Orhanie on Monday.  
**WEST INDIES.**  
Disastrous Hurricane.  
HAVANA, 15. St. Thomas advises state that a fearful hurricane visited Curacao and the neighboring islands on September 23d, and caused great damage. The wind blew from all quarters. The sea washed away the lower part of the town of Willemstad. Nearly every house in what is known as Petimay quarter, was destroyed, and the fortifications are in ruins. Many families are destitute. The damage to property is estimated at over half a million. A Dutch man-of-war and two Dutch schooners were wrecked and several lives lost. All the salt ponds in the neighboring island of Bonaire are ruined.
