THE PROVO RAIDERS.—A number of officers from Camp Douglas, accompanied by a cavalry guard of twenty-five men, left to-day for Camp Rawlins, where they have gone to conduct the trial of the men who took part in the late raid on the citizens of Provo.

NEPOTISM EXTRAORDINARY.—Nepotism in official circles is very common, and in the United States and every other country it is no uncommon thing to see the juvenile offshoots and relations of influential men, occupying places of profit and trust of which they have had the disposal. This is so common that its existence excites little or no comment. But in Utah a new phase of the business has been started, which, we venture to say, has scarcely been heard of before, let alone practiced, in this or any other Territory, State or country, and that never would be, by parties having the least conception of professional dignity or of honor, and propriety. The branch of nepotism, as practiced here, is the running of what is now claimed to be a V. S. Court, under the joint auspices, management and control of a father and son; the old man displaying his prejudice, incapacity, and lack of every other requisite necessary in one holding such a responsible and dignified position, and his hopeful offshoot acting as chief cook and bottle washer in a legal capacity. The juvenile we refer to recently served a kind of apprenticeship to a legal firm in this city, and being intimately connected with the "ring," after being "cocked" and "puffed" for the occasion, was admitted to practice at the bar in this Territory, and his father, who was his own book, as an expounder of the law, was in his father's Court, the job realizing, according to his own admission, several hundred dollars! We wonder how large a share of the spoils fell to the old man? Now we venture to assert that it would be extremely difficult to find an exhibition like this anywhere else. A man presiding over a Court and playing into the hands of his son so that they may jointly share not only the benefits of the official salary of a U. S. Judge, but also the legal fees arising from business transacted during the term of Court. Wonder what the respectable members of the bar in this city and Territory think of such an exhibition of jobbery? If they do not look upon it as derogatory to the dignity of both "Bench and Bar" we are much mistaken! Truly Illinois is a great State!

CAUTIONERS AND SAMPLERS.—A few days ago we stated, in the News, that Messrs. S. W. Howland & Co., Samplers and Crushers, of San Francisco, were putting up a building near the railroad depot, in which they purposed carrying on business. The building is now erected and in it is the necessary crushing and pulverizing machinery run by steam power. Work was commenced on Saturday last. Some idea may be formed of the enterprise of this firm from the fact that within two weeks after the arrival of the principal, Mr. Howland, to make arrangements for beginning business here, work had been commenced. Their establishment will doubtless prove of great benefit, especially to those who are inexperienced in mining matters, as it will enable such, as well as others, to dispose of their ores to advantage. Ores that have passed through the crushing and pulverizing machines can be much easier shipped to a distance, than as it comes from the mines, for, besides other advantages, the bulk is thus considerably reduced.

MONTANA ITEMS.—The following items, pertaining to that land of wonders, Montana, are from the *Pick and Pile* of the 29th ultimo:

"A species of the sugar maple is found in the canyons of Montana, and it has been ascertained that its sap is as strongly saccharine as the sap of the Florida sugar maple. It is found in the Upper Willow Creek is cultivating some of these native maples."

"Many have seen and admired the rock globes found on the Cannon Ball river, which implies into the Missouri several hundred miles below this point. These perfect spheres, weighing from five to ten pounds to many pounds weight. Broken open, the centre is found to consist of a malleable metal ring when struck with a hammer. Another stream has been found in Northern Montana in which these wonderful spheres are found. The popular opinion of their origin is that they are the result of descending lava, which had been thrown up to an immense height by volcanic convulsions—the same physical law acting that is applied in the manufacture of shot."

"The country about the great geysers of the Upper Yellowstone is fitted with cougars, or mountain lions—next to the grizzly the most dangerous and ferocious animals of North America. They burrow in the earth, but will climb trees with the agility of a timber squirrel, and with sufficient strength to capture the mountain hare in a fair race."

NEW RAILROAD AND TELEGRAPH LINE.—It will be seen from the following, which we take from a late number of the *Helena Gazette*, that there is a fair prospect for a new Railroad and Telegraph line, in this western country:

"The articles of incorporation of the Helena, Big Horn and Cheyenne Railroad and Telegraph Company have been filed in the Secretary's Office at Helena. The Recorder's Office of the same place has the purpose of constructing a Railroad and Telegraph line, between the City of Helena, and running thence Southeastwardly to the Three Forks, up the Gallatin Valley, and thence by the shortest and most practicable route to a point on the Southern boundary of Montana, where it will be met by the Cheyenne, Iron Mountain and Pacific Railroad, for the construction of which a company has been organized in Cheyenne."

This line, when completed, will connect with, and will doubtless be a valuable tributary to the Northern Pacific, and will also be advantageous to the U. S. and it is consequently expected that these two lines will lead their influence to the project. Eastern Capitalists are also interested in the enterprise and will probably give it hearty and substantial support.
