

THE JURY LIST.

In pursuance of section four of an Act of Congress in relation to courts and judicial officers of the Territory of Utah, approved June 23, 1874, Honorable Elias Smith, Probate Judge of Salt Lake County, and Joseph F. Nounnan, Clerk of the District Court of the Third Judicial District of the Territory of Utah, met at the office of the Probate Judge, at the Court House, in Salt Lake County, on this 23rd day of July, 1874, and then and there prepared a Jury list from which Grand and Petit Juries are to be drawn to serve in the District Court of the Third Judicial District of the Territory of Utah, to be held in said County of Salt Lake, pursuant to the provisions of said Act, and the proclamation of His Excellency, the Governor, dated July 14, 1874, and until a new list shall be made as provided by said Act; the names on said list being alternately selected by said Clerk and Probate Judge from among the male citizens of the United States who have resided in said District for the six months next preceding, and who can read and write the English language.
