## FRUIT EXHIBIT AT CONGRESS.

Preparations Making for a Large Display from This and Surrounding States.

## PAYETTE SENDS 300 VARIETIES.

Baptist Convention Meetings—Demurrer in School Controversy—Wedding Bells.

The fruit exhibit at the Eleventh Irrigation congress this month promises to be one of the finest ever placed on display anywhere in the United States. Communications are being received at the headquarters from all parts of the surrounding states asking that space be saved for their respective displays. What promises to be one of the largest and most complete exhibits is coming from the Payette Valley, Idaho. A letter has been received by Hon. F. J. Kiesel from Mr. A. B. Moss, who has in charge the preparing of that exhibit, stating that he will surely have 300 varieties of fruit on exhibition and ask that space be provided for them. Not less than 5000 feet, then their exhibit will have to be built eight feet high. This exhibit will arrive on the morning of Sept. 14. Numerous individuals have applied for space for their respective displays. Judge J. H. Richards of Boise City will be present and deliver an address on "Fruit Growing Under Irrigation."

Hon. Mons. Peterson of Montebello, Utah, also has been invited to deliver an address on "Fruit Growing Under Irrigation."

Gov. Peabody of Colorado has written that he has referred the matter of their state fruit exhibit to the state board of horticulture, who will prepare a good display.

The California board of trade has appointed its secretary, Mr. J. A. Filcher, who is also commissioner to the St. Louis exposition, to attend the congress and speak on "Colonization and the Fruit Industry."

Mrs. Elizabeth Shield, one of the most prominent ladies of California, who is recognized as authority on horticulture and viticulture, has been invited to deliver an address on "Fruit Growing Under Irrigation."

Senator Foster of Washington has sent his regrets at not being able to attend the congress, but will render irrefragable support at Washington, D. C.

SENATOR CLARK WILL PRESIDE.

Senator A. C. Clark, who has been in Paris, has written the board of control of the Irrigation Congress, that he will arrive home in time to preside over the deliberations of that assembly.

Frederick Booth Tucker has asked for 20 minutes in which to deliver his address on "Colonization."

The time will be granted him and as Mr. Tucker has given this subject a great deal of thought and attention, his address will doubtless be highly interesting.

A. J. McCune, second vice president of the congress, writes from Denver stating that that state will send in a display of beets.

MORE MONEY NEEDED.

The board of control held a meeting last night at which reports were received, one from the finance committee stating that in order to carry out the elaborate plans of Senator Clark, it was necessary to raise an additional \$2,500. This amount it was thought, could be raised and the congress be enabled to adjourn free from indebtedness. It was also decided to make an extra appropriation of \$500 for the committee for preparing the irrigation exhibit on the grounds of the state school for the deaf and blind. This will make \$1,500 appropriated for this purpose and State Engineer Doremus states that with this assistance they will be able to make an exhibit which will prove highly interesting to all. Further arrangements for the entertainment of the delegates were also discussed.
