AGRICULTURAL SOCIETY.

Meeting of Mill Creek Farmers' Association of Importance Discussed and Resolutions Adopted.

CONVENTION OF THE NEWS.

Mrs. L. G. Lusk, Dec. 25.—The Mill Creek Agricultural Society met in the ward house a few days ago for the first time this winter with President N. D. Jensen in the chair, and H. K. North as secretary pro tem.

President Jensen urged the necessity of organization among the farmers of Utah, so as to mutually benefit one another, and by combined effort, their land and protect the interest of the agriculturist. He stated that the farmers should incorporate their interests, hold and run a common house, buy mill, creameries and other institutions beneficial to them, and thereby protect themselves, keep up the price of their products, and by supplying the market a better market and side of Utah, but our articles, he thought that the farmers should be better represented in our legislative assemblies, so as to have better laws for the interest of agriculturist, mentioned the great traffic in the country by the sale of lands to the east and other industries, which caused a great loss to the state of genuine farm products and drained the country of money. He recommended that the farmers join the State Agricultural Society, and see the holding of farmers' institutes this winter, as well as keep up their local society meetings every month.

Mrs. E. A. Hill, from Salt Lake City, was greatly in favor that all the different agricultural societies should join their interests together, this was a strong statement, and the members of our Legislature were mostly law breakers, and they do not understand what the farmers want, and our interests would very likely be neglected if we do not take steps to protect them. He gave good advice in regard to the necessity of increasing our water systems, and fighting along with the government to have a common house, owned and controlled by the farmers, would not have been from 25 to 30 per cent, and that there would be held a territorial farmers' convention after Christmas, in Salt Lake City, under the auspices of the State Agricultural Society, and urged every farmer to attend.
