WASHINGTON, March 22.—Several friends of silver currency in the Senate claim to have positive assurance from President Cleveland that he will send a delegation to Brussels in May, to represent the United States at the international monetary conference, and that he has already taken steps to notify the various nations taking part in the conference. It is believed that the delegation will be composed of men of high standing in the country. Among the names suggested as the possible choice, are Edward Simmons, a prominent New York banker, ex-Chief Justice of the United States, and ex-Secretary of the Treasury, and ex-Secretary of the Treasury.
