FORTY-SEVENTH CONGRESS.

SENATE.

WASHINGTON, 25.—To-day having

been set apart for services in

Senate adjourned until to-morrow.

SENATE.

WASHINGTON, 25.—The naval bill

came up as the regular order, with

pending amendment recommended

by the committee, the first amend-

ment providing that chiefs of bu-

reaux shall receive no additional

pay by reason of holding such po-

sitions; rejected.

The next amendment being that

for the payment of \$100,000 for

the use by the United States of

his invention in torpedoes, was

agreed to and the bill passed.

The House went into committee

Wired From Washington.

WASHINGTON, 25.—There were

no witnesses before the special com-

mittee on the improvement of the

Mississippi to-day, but Represen-

tative Ellis put in the following dis-

patch in regard to the charge of

bribery:

St. Louis, Jan. 24, 1883.

E. John Ellis:

I am not in a condition to partici-

late in any sort of excitement. I

will say, however, Cowden is a

liar, and so is Captain Reid or may

be.

The charge came from Captain

Cowden, who has been before the

committee for several days advocat-

ing his only system. He said to

Ellis that Baldwin told him that

(Baldwin) had been approached by

the Ellis interest in the river con-

struction, and told him that he

had a slice of the \$500,000 to be

awarded for the improvement of the

river at Plum Point Beach. He

would keep his mouth shut, and

at once telegraphed Baldwin, and

in response received the above dis-

patch. The committee received the

matter in the light of bribery and

as evidence. No witnesses have

been called to substantiate or deny

the charge.

The National Bank of Bar-

ket, Oregon, is authorized to

commence business; capital \$50,000.

Rear Admiral Pierce Oroqui, com-

manding the South Atlantic squad-

The claim of Red Cloud presented

to the Indian Bureau, for pay for
