The Directors of the World's Fair Decide It at Last.

ADMITTANCE GIVEN TO THE PARK.
The Buildings Will be Held Closed.—
The Music Row—Business Failures.

CHICAGO, May 12.—The World's fair gates will be open to the public a week from next Sunday and the vexed question settled. Today at the regular monthly meeting of the local directors of the World's Fair, it was decided to open the gates of Jackson Park for half the sum of admittance to the Fair during the week, viz., 25 cents. This action has nothing to do with opening the buildings. The latter will remain closed as required under the laws and as agreed to when the \$2,000,000 was accepted from the Fifty-second Congress.

Edwin Walker, attorney for the board, submitted an opinion on the question and on the strength of this opinion the board acted.

TOLEDO, O., May 12.—The Ottawa County Bank at Elmore, O., closed its doors today, the result of the failure of the Columbia National Bank of Chicago. The outbreak is that depositors will be paid in full.

RECEIVERS FOR A STEEL FURN.

ST. LOUIS, May 12.—In the circuit court at Belleville this afternoon the Belvoir Steel company confessed its inability to pay \$2,371,000 in favor of Frederick W. Oliver of St. Louis. A bill of relief was asked for and Charles Becker and Bernard Yach were appointed receivers. Messrs. Dell & Meissner, attorneys for the company, made the following statement: "As soon as the receiver has been appointed over the ground a more complete statement of the affairs of the company will be forthcoming. In the meantime, it may be said with safety that all claims will be paid out during the year. So far as appears to this time the assets and liabilities are as follows: Assets, \$140,000; liabilities, \$150,000."

PAYMENT SUSPENDED.

LOS ANGELES, May 12.—The firm of M. J. Thomas & Son, leather dealers in old Kentucky whisky to the world, suspended payment this morning as the result of losses in the whisky trade and the high money market. The partners are considerably over \$100,000 in debt, and have exacted this sum by largely overcharging. In all probability the firm will be permitted to continue in business, and it is thought, in a short while will be relieved of all embarrassment.
