

TELEGRAPHIC. SUNDAY QUESTION.

The Directors of the World's Fair
Decide It at Last.

ADMITTANCE GIVEN TO THE PARK.

The Buildings Will be Held Closed—
The Music Room—Business
Fallows.

CHICAGO, May 12.—The World's fair gates will be open to the public a week from next Sunday and the vexed question settled. Today at the regular monthly meeting of the local directors of the World's Fair, it was decided to open the gates of Jackson Park for half the sum of admittance to the fair during the week, viz. 25 cents. The action has nothing to do with the opening of the grounds, but with the opening of the buildings. The latter will remain closed as required under the laws and as agreed to when the \$2,500,000 was accepted from the Fifty-second Congress.

Edwin Walker, attorney for the board, submitted an opinion on the question and on the strength of this opinion the board acted. The entire session of the National Commission today was spent in wrangling over the report of the Theodore Thomas investigating committee. Friends of the committee have been endeavoring to defeat the object of the committee, which was the adoption of a report practically ordering the discrediting of the committee. When the committee met Chairman Lannan moved the adoption of his report. President Palmer called for the year and day, but Judge St. Clair objected to the vote proceeding, stating that it was wrong morally and legally for the commission to take such action. By the time he had disappeared and Chairman Lannan seeing that it would be useless to attempt to have the report adopted, moved that the report be laid on the table until a quorum was secured, which was carried without a dissenting vote.

A resolution was adopted which, unless reconsidered tomorrow, will make the commission take a recess until May 21st. The property of having a "Wheelmen's day" at the World's Fair, during which mounted cyclists will be admitted to the grounds and allowed to parade during the morning and have a torchlight procession in the evening, was brought to the attention of the committee on resolutions by Addison C. Thomas. The committee assigned May 21st as the day.

BANKRUPTCY FAILURES.
The Bank of Oregon and Other Concerns in Financial Trouble.

MADISON, Wis., May 12.—The Bank of Oregon, established about a year ago by Dwight, Hartman & Co. of Chicago, made an assignment today. The closing of the bank was due to the collapse of the Columbia National Bank of Chicago.

CLOSED FOR DOORS.
Toledo, O., May 12.—The Ottawa County Bank, at Toledo, O., closed its doors today, the result of the failure of the Columbia National Bank of Chicago. The bank was in liquidation and its deposits will be paid in full.

RECEIVED FOR A STEEL YARD.
St. Louis, Mo., May 12.—In the circuit court at St. Louis this afternoon the Belleville Steel company confessed judgment in the sum of \$271 in favor of Fidelity W. Oliver of St. Louis. A bill of sale was filed for and Charles Becker and Bernard Yoch were appointed receivers. Messrs. Oliver & Fidelity, attorneys for the company, made the following statement: "As soon as the receivers have looked over the ground a more complete statement of the affairs of the company will be forthcoming. In the meantime, it may be said with safety that all claims will be paid during the year. So far as it appears at this time the assets of the company are as follows: Assets, \$940,000; liabilities, \$900,000."

PAYMENT SUSPENDED.
LEAVELAND, May 12.—The firm of M. H. Thomas & Son, the largest dealers in old time whiskey in the world, suspended payment this morning as the result of failure in the whiskey trade and the tight money market. The firm had been over a year and a half in business and had accumulated a debt of nearly one-half million. It is probable the firm will be permitted to continue to operate, but it is thought, in a short while will be relieved of all embarrassment.

THE CORDAGE TROUBLE.
BOSTON, May 12.—Judge Lacombe today appointed Charles H. Paxon and James H. Stevens receivers for the Standard Cordage company, the Sewell & Day Cordage company and the Chelsea Cordage company in the state of Massachusetts, all of which are subsidiaries of the National Cordage company and involved in its trouble.

A STOCK CITY FAILURE.
ROCKY CITY, Mo., May 12.—Today W. P. Thomas assigned. The Rocky City Dry Goods company filed a schedule of assets and liabilities of \$102,211, against \$241,700 in the original schedule. The liabilities as formerly filed are settled at \$222,000.
