AN ORDINANCE, Incorporating the Perpetual Emigrating Company.

Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the General Assembly of the State of certificates, bills, vouchers, as well Deseret, that the General, or a Special Conference of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, to be called at such time and place as the First Presidency of said Church shall appoint—is hereby authorized to elect, by a majority, a company of not less than thirteen men, one of whom shall be designated as their President, and the others, Assistants.

Sec. 2. This Company is hereby made and constituted a body corporate under the name and style of the Perpetual Emigrating Company; and shall have perpetual succession, and may have and use a common seal, which they may alter at pleasure.
