Washington, Sept. 21.—Anthony Comstock today announced his decision in the matter of section 2528 of the new tariff law. He holds in effect that goods coming directly from the United States from foreign countries, but which have been previously imported into the United States, are not subject to the discriminating duty of 10 per cent and also holds that foreign goods shipped from countries other than the United States are not subject to the discriminating duty. This decision was made after a long and arduous fight, and it is believed that the discriminating duty of 10 per cent will be removed from the tariff law.
