New York, Nov. 28.—At yesterday's meeting of the Union Pacific railway reorganization committee it was settled that the reorganization must include the whole Union Pacific system. One of the sub-committees said this morning, "I believe we can come to a general agreement by saying that the full committee probably agreed that any plan of reorganization is to be necessarily must include the entire Union Pacific system. Mr. Fisher in Trouble.

LAKEWOOD, Wyo., Nov. 27.—Mr. Fisher, a rancher from North Park, Colorado, claims that his partner, Dr. W. Bassett, has defrauded him out of several thousand dollars. The parties recently sold \$2,000 worth of cattle, and the money was deposited in the Laramie national bank in the Elkhorn circle. Afterwards Fisher claimed Bassett directed the conduct of the bank, and that he had given Fisher as he was in no way interested in it. Dr. Bassett has taken part of the money and gone to Denver.

Fisher also claims that upon the completion of the railroad he tried to sell it at \$100,000, but the property which was appraised to be worth \$15,000, but he now learns that it is mortgaged for nearly all it is worth. Fisher expects to begin a suit for damages against Bassett.

Want \$500 Per Month.

ORLANDO, Fla., Nov. 28.—Honorable Clark, Stark, Anderson, Chase and Conant, of the U.
