IN MEMORIAM.

Died at Green River, on the U. P. R. R., while traveling to Utah, with the company of saints that arrived in Ogden on Saturday, June 8th, Thomas Mills, late of Birmingham, England. Brother Mills was a faithful member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, through a period of 32 years, having embraced the gospel in the year 1850, in Walsall, near Birmingham (his native place), being 82 years old at the time of his death. The old gentleman had long looked forward with fond anticipation, to a re-union with his children in Utah, having one daughter, Sister Hannah Wardley, residing in Enterprise, Morgan County, and two sons, Richard L. Mills, of West Weber, Weber County, William Mills, of Paradise Cache County. His daughter (through whose exertions and self-sacrifice, combined with the assistance of her brothers and kind friends and acquaintances of the family Bro. Mills was enabled to emigrate) they received his remains at Peterson Station, and conveyed them to Enterprise.

On Monday, the 5th inst., at two p. m., funeral services were held in the Enterprise meeting house, when after singing by the choir, "Unveil thy bosom, faithful tomb," and prayer, suitable discourses were delivered by Bishop Hall, Elders William Biddle and George Larkins, of Ogden; Chas. S. Peterson and President Carrigan, of Peterson; Elders Thos. Palmer and Joseph L. Card, of Enterprise. The choir sang "Farewell all earthly honors," etc., when the remains of Bro. Mills were borne to their last resting place, to await the resurrection of the just. A numerous company of relatives and friends followed to the grave, in the little unpretentious cemetery overlooking the beautiful meandering river in Weber Valley.

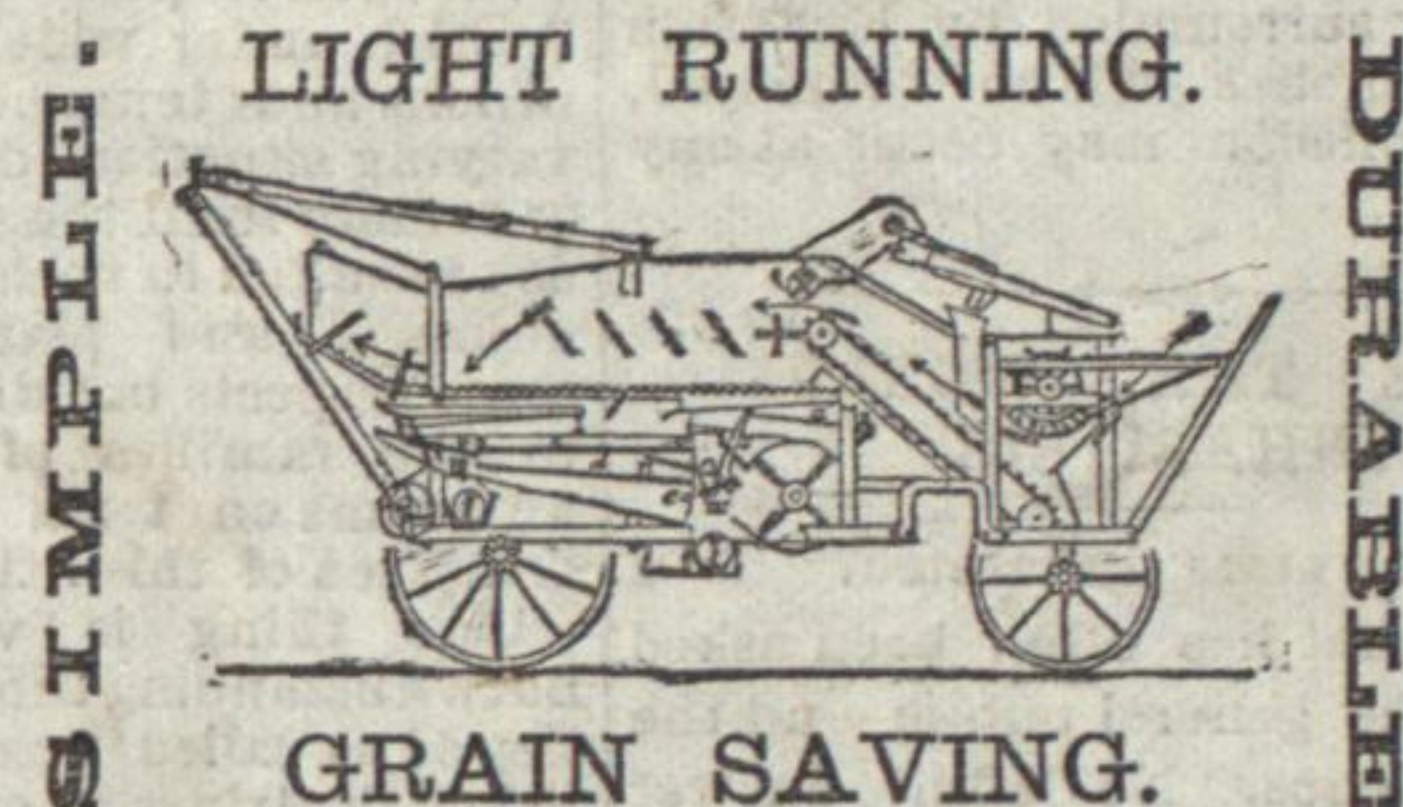

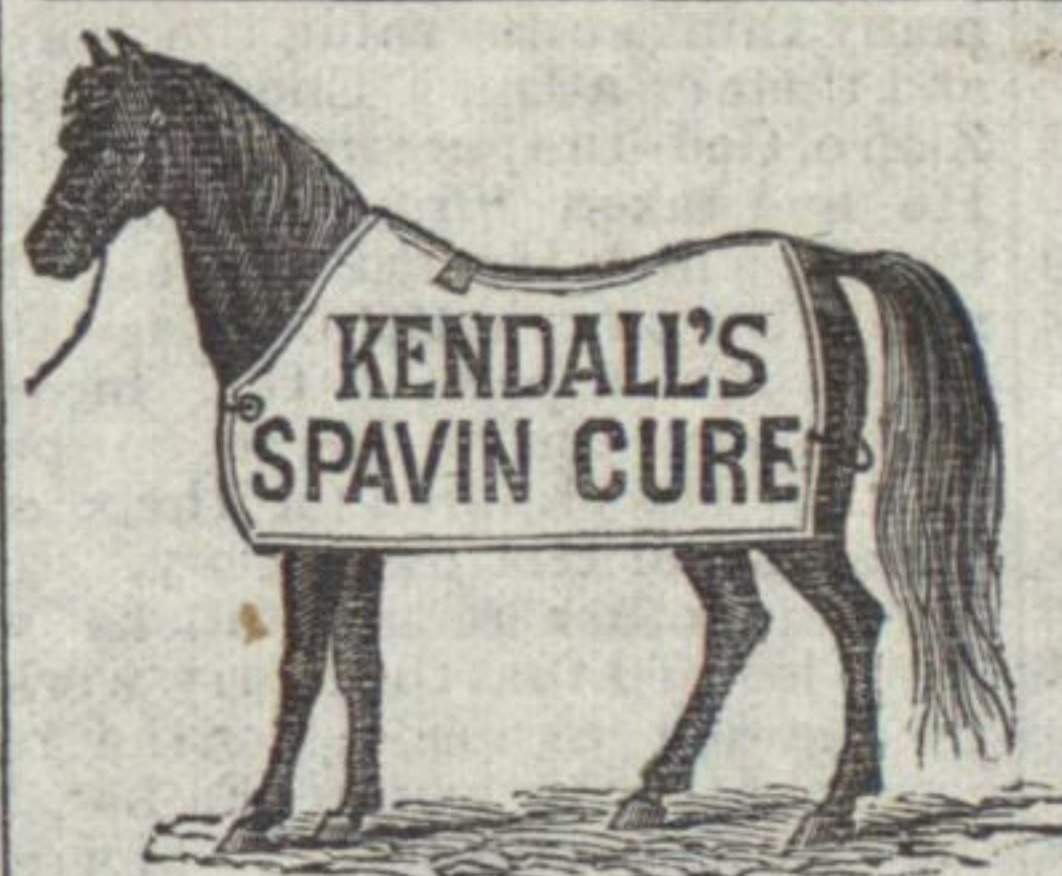
CANTON MONITOR ENGINE.
