

**HORNER'S HARVESTER.**—Brother John Horner, of Mission San Jose, California, has recently invented and patented a machine, called Horner's Harvester, which will cut, thrash, clean and sack, ready for market, fifteen acres of grain per day. It is put to its utmost capacity with only twenty acres per day. It cuts grain in two rows, and requires three men and two horses to run it. Last summer Mr. Horner harvested over two thousand acres of grain with this machine, at a cost of one acre of three and a half dollars; with other machines it is said to average five dollars.
