CONVENTION NEWS.

The Republians, National, State & Sectional—Utah Contested.

Michigan, June 7.—Ex-Senator Reed delivered a brief, but interesting speech, which was frequently and loudly applauded. Referring to the activities of the Democratic party, particularly, exciting interest among the audience.
