

MALAD-BURLEY SURVEY FINISHED

Two Lines Run by Corps of Engineers Working Since Last Winter.

ON BIG MAIN LINE CUT-OFF.

Not Anticipated Any Actual Construction Will Commence Until River Lines Get Busy, However.

C. E. Drummond, locating engineer for the Oregon Short Line, has returned to Malad, having completed the work of running a survey from that point to Burley, Idaho. Should the road ultimately be built it is stated that the cost of construction will come close to \$50,000 a mile.

It will be recalled that the Oregon Short Line exhibited feverish haste over this survey last winter and Mr. Drummond and his men were sent out post haste into deep snow and got down to work at once. Soon after they started out of Malad another party under Engineer Stradley left Burley and began to work toward the Drummond outfit. The first survey was completed early in the spring, but Mr. Drummond was kept in the field and went to work on another survey. The outcome is that the office of the chief engineer of the Oregon Short Line is now in possession of two surveys and field notes covering the same. One is a continuation of the Malad branch while the other leaves the line at a point about 15 miles south of Malad. The survey now completed, if extended on towards the main line, will give the Oregon Short Line a cut-off and materially reduce the gradients between Ogden and Nampa, Idaho, affording quicker transportation between Salt Lake and Portland. It is not anticipated, however, that work will be commenced until some rival invades Idaho and the northwest in earnest.

WRECK ON SAN PEDRO.

Passenger Train Leaving Here Saturday Night Derailed on Desert.

Los Angeles, Sept. 16.—Derailed by a defective switch from the track of which a nut had either fallen or been maliciously removed, overland train No. 1, on the San Pedro, Los Angeles and Salt Lake railroad, southbound from Salt Lake, was badly damaged at Helen station between Daguerre and Colton today but no one of the 200 passengers or crew were injured. Several persons were slightly bruised by being thrown from their Pullman berths.

An examination made by General Manager Wells, who was on board No. 1 at the time of the accident, showed that the loss or removal of the nut had left the switch unlocked. The two heavy locomotives pulling the desert train kept the main track as did the Pullmans, but the last coach took to the siding. Engineer Arthur Smith applied the air, stopping the train within eight engine lengths. The locomotives left the rails, one of them coming to a stop at right angles to the track. The standard and day coaches also were derailed but not overturned. Several "rescues" were made of passengers, but these were of a humorous rather than a thrilling nature.

A special sent out from Los Angeles brought the delayed travelers into this city tonight.

AIR BRAKES ON PENN. R. R.

New York, Sept. 17.—In a report to the interstate commerce commission, the Pennsylvania railroad shows that on its line east of Pittsburgh and Erie, it owns 133,411 freight cars and that 130,915, or 98 per cent of these are equipped with air brakes.

A report was requested from all the roads of the country by the commission to learn whether or not the law requiring 75 per cent of freight cars to be equipped with air brakes, was being complied with.

BURLINGTON SURVEY.

Party of Engineers Working West From Guernsey to Salt Lake.

(Special to the "News.") Guernsey, Wyo., Sept. 17.—A party of Burlington engineers arrived here this week and are now working from Guernsey west. They will not discuss their plans, but it is known they are checking up surveys made several years ago for an extension of the Burlington from Guernsey to Salt Lake City, Utah. Recently Chief Engineer Calvert made a trip by wagon over the route of the proposed line.

HOLY CROSS INTACT.

Rio Grande Scouts Expedition to Investigate Historic Mountain.

Just as has only recently been done to one of the most famous mountains of Colorado. For some years a persistent rumor has been afloat that the famous Mount of the Holy Cross had suffered an accident in the shape of a rock slide which had destroyed one of the arms of the cross, or rather had filled up one of the transverse canyons and excluded the snow therefrom, thus obliterating a portion of the cross. Photographs showing this defect have actually been made, but a short time ago the Denver & Rio Grande Railroad sent its photographers, W. H. Jackson, the noted landscape artist of Detroit, and George L. Beam of Denver, on a trip to the wonderful Holy Cross region for the purpose of proving or disproving the statement as to the partial destruction of the cross. Leaving the town of Red Cliff, after an immense amount of hard traveling through an almost unbroken wilderness, the summit of Aetna mountain (a long and jagged eminence directly opposite the Mount of the Holy Cross) was reached, and from the first point of view one of the arms of the cross did appear to be missing. However, on bearing to the right and rising over a fine thread of snow became visible on that portion of the summit, and after continuing in this direction for some distance the entire left arm appeared, and it was found that the cross was as complete and beautiful as ever. A comparison of the new photographs with the first one ever made, which Mr. Jackson took 33 years ago, shows practically no change even in the spots of snow on the mountain, to say nothing of any alterations in the masses of rock of which it is composed. Evidently the story of the demolition was started by persons who had not ascended to the

WORK ON VIADUCT.

Short Line Starts Operations on Concrete Piers for Big Bridge.

Work in the Oregon Short Line yards in the vicinity of the site for the new handsome depot is proceeding gaily. The steam shovel that has been at work for the past month has decidedly altered the topography of the section attacked. The big freight house is now almost ready for occupancy while the painters have completed the coloring of the long shed roof which is one city block in length. Preliminary are now under way on the big viaduct that is to span the net work of tracks on North Temple street. Big concrete abutments are now going in and in a few weeks the structural steel will be received and placed preliminary to completing the bridge which will afford safe passage for pedestrians, vehicles and street cars from the west side up town.

Just as now as the viaduct is completed actual work will commence on the erection of the handsome joint depot for the Oregon Short Line and the Salt Lake Route which will stand across the foot of South Temple street.

There was quite a little painting in evidence today on the political signs. With all three political offices located within speaking distance of each other, the politicians are concentrated more than was the habit last year, when east Second South street shared with west Second South street the honor of being a center for gatherings of curbstone experts on national policies, and local problems.

The painting today is in the nature of signs pointing the way. They are located at and near all headquarters of no man here any show to go to take conferences intended for Martineau to his brother named Danner across the street, in the hallway of the Atlas block, where Democratic headquarters are located a large new sign flares the simple words "Democratic Club" at the far end of the hall large letters announce "Main Entrance" instead of the old legend, "Headquarters Young Men's Democratic Club."

Across the street a banner hung far out from the Currier and Ives block, "American Party Headquarters" and inside index fingers point the way to the reading room from which doors open into the more private retreats of the party leaders. Clear smoke hangs heavily in all the rooms, and the newsmen are much in demand for the gang is all there waiting for the barrel to leak, while the party officers plan work for heelers and district canvassers.
