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HARTFORD, Conn., 5.—Greely's majority is 408.

NEW HAVEN, Conn., 5.—Greely's majority is 418.

SOUTH BEND, Ind., 5.—Grant's majority is 418.

PLATTSMOUTH, Neb., 5.—This city gives Grant 24 majority.

CHICAGO, 5.—Eighteen precincts of eight wards, and one town in Cook county give Grant a net majority of 815.

THE STATE has probably gone for Grant by thirty or forty thousand.

Private dispatches from New York say that New Jersey has gone Republican by three thousand majority.

Greely's majority in New York city is twenty-two thousand. In the State, however, is elected mayor.

Des Moines, 5.—The indications are that Grant has carried the State by 40,000 majority.

UTICA, 5.—Ellis H. Roberts is elected to Congress by 3,500 majority.

Grant's majority in Ontario county is 8,000.

BALTIMORE, 5.—Greely has 9,000 majority.

ROCHESTER, 5.—Grant has 1,500 majority.

The State will give Dix 40,000.

NEW YORK.—Havemeyer seems to have been elected mayor.

RICHMOND, Va., 5.—Virginia is conceded to Greely by 6,000.

DETROIT, 5.—Michigan gives Grant 80,000.

NEWARK, N. J., 5.—The returns from the State are incomplete, but indicate from 300 to 400 for Grant.

BOSTON, 5.—Grant's majority in Massachusetts is about 60,000.

NEW YORK, 5.—The vote at midnight is that all the old Northern States with South Carolina and Mississippi, in a total of 235 electoral votes, have declared for Grant, leaving 113 electoral votes for Greely.

Grant will have at least 40,000 majority in the State.

New York Greely is running behind Kernan and the State ticket at least 15,000 votes.

The Liberal gains in the rural districts of the Republican counties are more than compensated for by the Grant gains in the cities of the State.

Havemeyer, at the time of writing, seems to be elected mayor.

O'Brien, though a favorite in the polls, being a bad third.

The local voters decided, excepting the mayor, are generally Tammany Democrats.

The Republican have the legislature of this State by a working majority.

ALEXANDRIA, Va., 5.—The vote between Greely and Grant is a tie.

Harris, Conservative, in the 7th district, is elected to Congress.

Hunt, Conservative, in the 8th district, is elected.

RALEIGH, N. C., 5.—The returns about twenty-five counties indicate that the State has gone for Grant by between 5,000 and 8,000.

CINCINNATI, 5.—Twenty wards and precincts show 562 Republican gain over the State election.

Similar changes in the rest of the county will reduce the Democratic majority to 25,000.

COLUMBUS, O., 5.—The returns so far received indicate that Grant's majority in the State will be 40,000.

MILWAUKEE, 5.—The Democratic concede that the Republican majority in the State is 2,161.

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
