MAD WITH FRIGHT.

Fire in a Six-Story Building Filled
With Sweet Shops.

PANIC AROSE POLISH JEWS.

The Bound and Fatty Immigrants
Fright by Their Escape—Dead
and Injured.

New York, June 15.—A six-story building in Montgomery street, filled with sweet shops, caught fire at 4 o'clock in the morning and in the wild rush to extinguish it and the wild run of a crowd of 250 people watching, there was, according to some men and women, names yet unknown, were killed and several injured. It is believed that the escapees were frightened by the fact that the fire shutters were spiked fast to all the windows leaving them, 500 others, jammed in front and caught like sardines.

The whole front of the building was filled with people, all fighting for good places on the fire escapes, and many suffered from the heat and smoke. One man was seen to jump from the penthouse, but yet in place, and several jumped from that point. The first was a woman who fell on the iron railing in front of the building and was killed. Next came two men who fell on the lower floor, and both were crushed.

Others landed on their feet, and suffered but little injury. The fire department finally got ladders alongside and assisted the persons who had been unable to get away, but by fright. It is expected that two or more of the injured will die. In the meantime, the building was on fire on every floor and took half an hour to subdue the flames. The dead were taken to the morgue. On Saturday, June 15, Morris Nechasp, a Polish tailor, and his daughter Alice were badly burned and will probably die.

THE LIZZIE BORDEN TRIAL.

Testimony of Medical Men, but Nothing of Importance.

NO Blood Found on Any of the Objects Connected with the Case.

New Bedford, Mass., June 15.—On re-opening of the Lizzie Borden trial this morning the cross-examination of Dr. D. C. Davis was continued, but nothing of special interest was brought out and he gave way to Dr. H. W. of Boston, medical witness. He testified that the bullet removed from the stomach of Mr. and Mrs. Borden that they had been poisoned. He had found no blood on anything connected with the case, either instruments or clothing, except a small amount of a white liquid which was human blood and probably came from the outside. The handkerchief might have been cleaned.

Draper also testified as an expert concerning the condition of the instruments and blood stains, and directed an examination of the tool that the instrument which produced the wound was three and a half inches long, the exact length of the handle being hidden.
