# GOLDFIELD CON. MILL.

# New Plant Will Cost \$700,000-Little Florence and Other Dividends.

# Special Correspondence.

Goldfield, Nev., Jan. 12.--Plans and specifications for the company mill of the Goldfield Consolidated Mines company are in the hands of contractors whose bids will shortly be opened for consideration. The reduction works, to the model plant of the world, will cost \$700,000. It will possess a capa-city of 500 tons daily; will be located west of the Sandstorm mine on Conwest of the Sandstorm mine on Con-solidated territory on the west slope of Columbia mountain, and be connected with the Combination. Goldfield Min-ing, Jumbo, Laguna, Mohawk, and Red Top merger diggings by three miles of standard gage railroads.

Top merger diggings by three miles of standard gage railroads. Actual milling of Consolidated ores will not exceed in cost \$2.50 per ton. The Hornestake plant in South Dakota treats 4,000 tons daily at 50 cents per ton, making a saving, by the additional cyanide treatment at 25 cents a ton, of 94 per cent the assay value of ore that runs \$4 to the ton.

94 per cent the assay value of ore that runs \$4 to the ton. Combination, Goldfield Mining, Jum-bo, Mohawk and Red Top have pro-duced approximately \$16,000,000, and to date have hardly been scratched. La-guna undoubtedly has ore bodies equal to those of the wonderful Red Top and it seems certain that Consolidated is destined to lay deep in the shade all previous records.
