They have temples and they have altars built, but these are dedicated to the 'Unknown God.' " I found this to be the truth. I found the word, the written word of God was read in every church in every land, and that every family had it; but I was surprised to find that but few of them were willing to receive the truths which are therein contained. They were content with the dead letter of the law; and when I undertook or attempted to explain the principles of life and salvation, the principles which Jesus Christ taught His disciples, and which they taught all those who would listen to their testimony. I found there was a great coolness. People would not listen, They were content with what they had received. This was my general experience. On the other hand I found very many who acknowledged to me the truth of that which I had said.
