**Dies From Appendicitis**—Andrew Grant of Woods Cross, aged 41, died of appendicitis yesterday at the hospital, leaving a wife and six children.

**To Investigate Cause**—Twenty-five sheep near Draper have died mysteriously in the last two days, and Dr. Gray of the state board of health has gone there to investigate.

**Apply for Irrigation Water**—Thomas Jeffery and A. Billings of Fremont, Utah, have filed with the state engineer an application for five second feet of water from Folk creek, with which to irrigate 329 acres.

**Hand Badly Injured**—John Major, an employee of the Inland Salt company, caught his hand in a belt at the refinery yesterday and was badly injured. Major was brought to the Valley Cross Hospital for treatment.

**French Motor Car**—Col. Clayton is in receipt of a fine foreign automobile from France. He was not required to pay duty as he had used it over a year, while abroad. A new car been new, the duty would have been \$2,000.

**Inquiring About Utah**—Paul Aylesworth of Needles, Cal., has written to the secretary of the M. and M. association asking for information for literature giving information of Utah, as he proposes to open a general store in southern Utah, and desires to know about conditions.

**Ride Over Projected Route**—Members of the city council rode over the projected route of the proposed Emigration Canyon railroad Monday. It is reported in petition for a franchise being looked upon with favor. The line begins at Fifth South and Thirteenth East streets, runs to Eighth South and then out beyond the city boundaries. A resort in the neighborhood of Wagner's brewery will be built if the road materializes.

**St. John's Postponed**—Vincent St. John, Goldfield labor leader and J. W. W. agitator, passed through Salt Lake yesterday en route to Denver, where he enters a blind hospital to be treated for blood poisoning. St. John was shot by Colly Mullane some time back and poisoning has resulted. It was reported at first that St. John was improving and would be able to lead the miners in present trouble, but his injuries appear to be much worse than at first supposed.

**Good Harvest at Corinne**—W. H. Howe is down from Corinne, where he reports the most successful harvests of all kinds for the season just closed. He speaks encouragingly of the farmers' school which has been established there through the instrumentalities of the local Farmers' institutes and the growing of agricultural benefit to the grassmen. The school has been listening to lectures from the professors of the Agricultural college with marked advantage.

**Submits Proposition**—A dispatch from Butte states that the Montana Federation of Labor has asked the management of the Bell Telephone company to reopen negotiations with a view to settlement of all differences between them and asks the company to submit a proposition. General Manager Murray has done so far as settling the question of the same stand taken by the company all the time, with reference to keeping and protecting all employees who have remained faithful to the company.

**Prosecution Strengthened**—In the case of the United States against the Utah Fuel company, in which depositions are now being taken of certain persons residing in New York and Washington, the prosecution is said to have been strengthened in its case. More financial juggling was indulged in at the council meeting last night. Out of a million dollar bond fund created in 1906, the council awarded Pat Moran \$37,929.63 for the new 36-inch water mains in Fifth South street. This leaves less than \$1,000 in the bond fund.
