TENDERED A RECEPTION.

Tabernacle Choir and Friends Entertained by President and Mrs. L. W. Shurtliff.

Improvements in Deer State School—Hearings in District Court—Trout Fry for Ogden River.

The beautiful home of President L. W. Shurtliff was the scene of splendor and delight last evening, when a grand reception was given the Ogden tabernacle choir by President Shurtliff, who is also president of the choir. One of the most important purposes of the gathering was that the presidency of the State might meet all the members of the new organization, and that all might become better acquainted and more united. The choir met at the tabernacle for practice, and after a short rehearsal, they adjourned, in a body, to their worthy president's residence, where they were most heartily welcomed by President Shurtliff and his wife.

The home was prettily decorated for the occasion. The walls and hallways were draped with the stars and stripes and potted plants and flowers in the parlors were well filled with the invited guests who numbered about 150. After the entire party had gathered, the president of the choir, Charles J. Rose, presided at the head of the table. The choir was given by President Shurtliff. Short addresses were also delivered by Vice-President Charles J. Rose, President C. F. Middleton and N. C. Fyfe, of the State and Prof. Joseph Ballentine, leader of the choir. After the speaking the choir sang. The evening was delightfully spent in music, song duets, graphophone selections and pleasant conversation, augmented with delicious refreshments. The choir and guests departed near midnight, feeling well paid for the happy hours spent together and the deep interest which President Shurtliff and his wife had in seeing and to everyone present had a delightful time.

The choir was only recently organized, but has made considerable progress, and has been heard from the able leadership of Prof. Ballentine. It is the intention of the Presidency of the State that the Ogden tabernacle choir be one of the foremost choirs in the state, and to that end they are putting forth every possible effort and no little credit is due to those who have had the choir under their supervision for the success to which it has already attained.

STATE DEAF MUTE SCHOOL.
A meeting of the board of directors of the state school for the deaf and blind was held yesterday afternoon. The matter of installing an electric plant with sufficient capacity to run the machinery in the carpenter shop, and laundry and the lighting of the buildings belonging to the institution was taken up and thoroughly discussed, but no definite conclusion was arrived at.

Supt. Briggs reported that there are at present 52 students in attendance at the school, 48 of whom are deaf and 4 who are blind. The school received application from 21 more students for admittance at the school next year. With this number added to the present number, the school will be very large, and the school will be filled to its capacity.

Supt. Briggs also reported that the greenhouse which has been under construction during the past few weeks, the pupils doing the work is now completed, and the plants growing very rapidly. The lettuce and radishes are almost large enough for table use. It is the intention of the management of the school to use one part of the greenhouse for raising plants, etc., for the flower beds; another part for cabbage, tomato and other garden plants; and another part for the greenhouse for raising banana, orange, guava, and other tropical trees and plants so that the students may study these trees, etc., just as they grow.

The superintendent reported that the construction of a henery for the institution would be commenced today, and when that is completed chickens, ducks, geese, turkeys and other fowls will be raised at the school.

The payrolls amounting to \$2,337.71 were allowed and the board adjourned for one month.
