Mountain Climbing Calls for Care.

A short walk along the crest of the ridge leads us to the first of the two crags which form the summit, and the next step is a gymnastic performance in which the climber is not only on his hands and feet, but also on his head and shoulders. The first peak rises up into a sharp wedge of rock covered by thin patches of snow like a snow fence, or like a snowdrift, showing with wind, and overhanging the perpendicular wall on the summit is a small ledge which is the only place where one can stand when we look up at it from the snow-white below. Around and under these leading slabs it is necessary to jump, run by one, placing one foot on the side of a little ledge. The latter being a hanging ledge, the climber is obliged to hang on by his hands and feet. It is some, however, to shift one's hold from one place to another, when the climber comes there are little protruding points which afford some footing. Then it is from these points one has to hang over, back, down, then in the reverse order. From "The Mountain Climber" by Edwin J. Hayes in "The Standard".
