NEW LAW TAKES EFFECT JULY 1

Regulations Which Must Be Lived Up to Regarding Nevada Mineral Locations.

SOME IMPORTANT CHANGES.

Must Define Boundaries of Claims Within Twenty Days After Posting of Notices.

New mining regulations as revised by the last session of the Nevada legislature as its meeting last winter are scheduled to go into effect next Monday.

Section 1. Any person, a citizen of the United States, or who has declared his intention to become such, who discovers a vein or lode may locate a claim upon such vein or lode by defining the boundaries of the claim in the manner hereinafter described...

Rate Went up to Eight Per Cent And Had an Effect on Stocks.

OPENING PRICES HIGHER.

When Selling Orders Appeared Gains Were Wiped Out—Bonds Were Irregular.

New York, June 28.—Opening prices of stocks showed general advances on a fair volume of business.

The signat gains at the opening were wiped out when selling orders appeared and the list eventually sagged to fractionally below yesterday's closing.

Marked increase in the demand for stocks after midday and prices rose rapidly in all directions.

The market closed weak and dull. The price of the failure of the New York City bond offering was followed by a general throwing over of stocks by traders.
