## MAN OF WEALTH DIES IN POVERTY

Legrade R. Anderson, Recently from Michigan, Dies in Ogden General Hospital.

OGDEN, Oct. 16.—Legrade R. Anderson, 15 years of age, of Lawton, Mich., died at the Ogden general hospital Thursday night at 11:30 of pneumonia and general debility, due to old age and the lack of proper food and care during the past several months. In his clothes were found checks for over \$6,000, notes, securities, collateral, bank stocks, etc., for more than \$30,000 and \$40 in cash. Since July, the time of his first appearance in Ogden, he has been living in a small room at the house of Mrs. Grace of Adams avenue, and his shabby appearance and the great economy of his living, convinced all who came in contact with him that he was a very poor man. The people at the house where he has been living say that at covert moments he let a few hints fall about his past life and there seem to be no doubt that he has been, and may have been at the time of his death, a very rich man. No one has ever hinted that he had left his eastern home because the husbands of his daughters did not want him around and therefore, rather than cause unpleasantness to arise in his family, he had sought out a remote place and had left his property to his children. A daughter, Mrs. Frank W. Williams, was communicating with us by telegraph and arrived this morning at 6 o'clock to take care in her father's remains, which is being prepared for shipment by Larkin & Sons' undertaking establishment.

### NEGRO STABBED IN DRUNKEN BRAWL

OGDEN, Oct. 16.—In a drunken fracas in a negro saloon last night, F. J. Labortus was seriously stabbed by Alex Watters, both colored. The two men had been drinking and quarreled. Blows were exchanged when when drew his knife and when Labortus severed a vein, inflicting several wounds in the body and one on the head, which is supposed to have caused a fracture of the skull. Labortus was taken to the hospital, but, although he had money, he refused to pay for treatment and was sent back to the saloon jail where his injuries were dressed by the county physician. Watters was arrested by Officer Chambers and taken to the city jail. The injuries to Labortus are considered serious.

### WOMEN ROBBED BY THUGS.

OGDEN, Oct. 16.—Last night, while Miss Hattie Burt was on her way home, she was accosted on Twenty-fourth street between Washington and Academy avenues by an unknown man and her hand snatched, which contained several dollars in change, was taken from her.

A Miss Lee had a similar experience of Twenty-fifth street and Washington avenue last night; her snatched being taken and contained only a small amount of money.
