POPE GRANTS DISPENSATION ENABLING NEW YORK GIRL'S MARRIAGE TO A BARON.

Added interest was lent to the Miss Irma Stern-Baron Von Graffenreid wedding by the fact that a special dispensation of the pope was necessary to the successful termination of a romance of no little interest.

Baron Leo is a son of the late Baron Emanuel von Graffenreid former Swiss minister to Austria. Baron Leo provided before his departure for this country for a dispensation from the Catholic church. He was assured that the papers would be forwarded to New York in ample time for the ceremony.
