

RETURN IN TRIUMPH. From the House of Blumrath's Entrance into Berlin.

THE GERMAN PEOPLE JUBILANT. (From the House of Blumrath's Entrance into Berlin.)

BERLIN, Jan. 25.—No conquering army ever had a more triumphant return to its capital than that which entered Berlin today. Ever since the first appearance of a new man, the German people have been waiting for a leader who would lead them to victory. Today they have found him in the person of Otto von Bismarck. The old statesman, who has been the guiding spirit of German policy for half a century, has returned to his capital in triumph. The people have gathered in the streets to welcome him, and the air is filled with the sound of bells and the cry of "Bismarck!"

PAINTING ON THE GALLIES. The Execution of the Murderer of Alice G. Martin.

CHICAGO, Jan. 25.—George H. Painter was executed at last night's midnight hour for the murder of Alice G. Martin. The execution was a quiet affair, and the murderer met his fate with a calm and steady gaze. The crowd of spectators was large, and the atmosphere was one of somber gravity. The executioner, a man of dark complexion and a stern expression, raised the guillotine's blade with a steady hand, and the murderer's head fell with a single stroke.

THE CHURCHY QUESTION. Corbett's Authority in the Matter Will Be Discussed by Congress.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 25.—The House Judiciary committee, by a vote of 9 to 1, ordered a favorable report on Corbett's authority in the matter of the churchy question. The committee's report was a thorough examination of the legal and constitutional issues involved in the case. It concluded that Corbett's actions were justified and that the churchy question should be resolved in his favor. The report was received with approval by the committee members, and it is expected that the full House will soon take up the matter.

HASBROUCK'S CASE. Judge Smith Decides in Favor of the Medical Board.

THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS, the State, Was Properly Appealed By the Attorney.

IN THE MATTER OF HASBROUCK'S CASE, a lengthy report of the Board of Medical Examiners, which had been appealed by the State, was heard by Judge H. W. Smith in the Third District Court. The case involved a dispute over the medical board's decision regarding the practice of medicine in the State. The board had ruled in favor of its own members, and the State had appealed the decision. Judge Smith, after a thorough review of the evidence and arguments, decided in favor of the medical board.

THE RESERVE. Washington, Jan. 25.—Chandler's report on the reserve, which had been submitted to the President, was received today. The report detailed the current status of the reserve and the steps being taken to improve it. It was a comprehensive document that covered all aspects of the reserve, from its composition to its training and equipment. The President is expected to review the report and make any necessary adjustments.

THE BUREAU OF THE BUREAU. The Bureau of the Bureau, which had been established by the President, was received today. The bureau was created to oversee the operations of the various departments and agencies of the government. It was a new addition to the executive branch, and its establishment was a significant step in the reorganization of the government.
