Logan, Oct. 11.—Yesterday afternoon a session of the Irvine trial in its 10th week was a continuation of the examination of jurors. Up to the time of adjournment, fifty-three jurors had been examined and challenged, with others in the box subject to peremptory challenges. The case had used three of the sixteen peremptory allowed.

In the Lamberton munitions proceedings, General Lamberton's side made a strong personal play before the supreme court for his client, the court having refused to allow the filing of Lamberton's transcripts. The court finally agreed to look over the papers, but gave little encouragement to the relator, saying that it was not their practice to interfere in such matters, and especially in this case. This effectively prevents Lamberton from assisting the prosecution after being exonerated by the defense.

This is the third day of the trial. Up to the more adjournment, it has been consumed in examining jurors. So far twenty-five men have been examined today, making a total of nearly eight altogether. The courtroom attendance is small, but great interest is manifested in the case on the outside. Counsel on both sides are unusually strict in the examination of each juror. So far opinions agree that the defense is gaining many points.

Irvine is well, and all the attorneys are in good condition. There was nothing worthy of particular mention during the morning. A jury will be sworn this afternoon, without doubt, the state having but one and the defense four challenges left. Up to now today no jury had been selected in the Irvine case, but the prospects are favorable in securing a "satisfactory panel." This afternoon there have been some examinations, forty-five of whom have been discharged from serving foremen, having expressed and still maintaining fixed opinions.

On the trial number insistent to serve, City were met by the relator, who would have given a favorable verdict for the defense had they been permitted to sit on the jury. This thought that some remittance should be induced, so some were severer than a very brief term. This is fairly typical of the sentiment to Lamberton, formed from the few facts gathered at the time of the tragedy.

The defense has testimony which will sustain this sentiment, but defense efforts will be made by the prosecution to sustain the introduction of the same.

Mr. Irvine is still sitting the trial as well as could be expected, and his main defense is ever at his side to offer their support and comfort.

Very short examinations of the jurors on state family conditions are being made, and it is safe to predict that it will finally be composed of married men exclusively.

Up to now the defense has experienced twelve of their sixteen peremptory challenges and the prosecution five of theirs. The prosecution has two surviving witnesses. The defense have not decided just how many they will put on the stand, but if they do expert testimony a hypothetical question will be asked requiring mostly an answer to it.

It is generally understood that the theory of temporary insanity will be set up by the defense, and when the terrible ordeal through which Mr. Irvine was compelled to go for nearly a week prior to the commission of the tragedy is known, it is generally believed here in Logan that the community will have but one thought—that of his examination.

ANOTHER DULL DAY

The Courts Showed No Improvement Upon Yesterday's Conditions.

ACROSS THE BORDER.

Joseph Hougham and his wife were in Logan yesterday evening to file the bill of particulars against the Salt Lake City Railroad Co., to recover \$300 and costs for personal injuries. In the complaint it is alleged that on Sept. 27th, 1891, Mrs. Hougham was a passenger on one of the defendant's company's cars, when with her son, a boy of eight years, and a companion of the defendant's servants a collision occurred between it and another car. She states that as the result of this she was severely injured and wounded, was sick and lame for several days thereafter, and suffered great pain of body and mind to the amount claimed.
