

DEWEY WILL ACT QUICKLY.

Administration Has Determined to Extend the Jurisdiction of the United States.

NAVAL CAMPAIGN TO PROCEED

As Soon as the Gunboats That Now Are on Their Way to Manila, Arrive, the Admiral Will Proceed to Restore Order in the Archipelago.

Washington, Feb. 17.—The administration has determined to extend the jurisdiction of the United States over the Philippine group in its entirety, acting on the theory that delay in this case is dangerous, and that anarchy and a general paralysis of such interests as the islands support will be brought about through a failure promptly to suppress the Spanish sovereignty over the islands by that of the United States. This decision involves the necessity of a naval campaign, and this will be instituted as soon as Admiral Dewey receives the reinforcements in the shape of gunboats now on the way to Manila.
