## BUT IS HE THE MAN?

A Strange Story Concerning One of Salt Lake's Police Officers.

During the greater part of last winter a man named H. H. Root was employed by Mr. Joshua Stewart, a milk dealer of this city, to deliver milk. He was in the habit of receiving payment from the customers on his master's behalf, but, having failed to account for something like \$100 or \$125, was called upon for a settlement. This was in the month of March, and a very short time afterwards Root skipped. The master was reported to Sheriff Burt, and Deputy Cummins was sent to work upon the case.

It was learned, in May, that a man corresponding with the description of the accused was traveling with Raymond's circus, as a sort of general hand, and that he was then in Denver. Recently the circus came to this city, and one of Mr. Stewart's sons, on going to the show, observed that he had seen Root there. Mr. Stewart immediately sent a warrant for the man's arrest, and Deputy Sheriff Cummins was sent to the circus to lay in the alleged embezzler. It was known, however, that in the meantime, Stewart was induced enough to talk with the man himself, and when the deputy got up to the circus, he found that Mr. Cummins had met Mr. Daniel C. Gould and Officer O'Brien there and asked them to look out for him. But Cummins, aware that O'Brien was not in the circus, said that he had no trouble in finding the man, that he had gone away, and that out of the circus he had helped him to get out of the place.
