DISINFECTANT.

SALT LAKE CITY, March 4, 1878.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Salt Lake City, have recently passed a resolution, regarding the Quarantine Physician to publish, as often as considered necessary, the best method for disinfecting, where cases of SCARLET FEVER and DYSENTERY exist.

The following is respectfully submitted: All cases should be isolated immediately as far as practicable.

All visiting and passing to and from the infected premises should be prohibited, only so far as is satisfactorily necessary for the proper nursing and caring for the sick.

The fumes of carbolic acid and chlorine gas should be freely used in the sick rooms, so that all bedding and clothing in the room of the patient shall be constantly disinfected.

The glasses, cups, spoons, etc., used in the sick room should not be used in any other part of the house, nor by any other members of the family; and should be cleaned several times daily in hot water containing chlorinated soda or carbolic acid.

The rooms in which the patient is kept should be constantly aired with the vapor of lime; easily procured by placing a tub or large bucket of water in one corner of the room and throwing in, sufficiently often to keep the water boiling, a lump of quick lime as large as a man's fist.

All rags and rubbish coming from the room should be carried some distance from the house and immediately burned or buried.

Neighbors visiting at the sick room for the purpose of rendering aid to the sufferers would do well to have an outer garment that could be easily put on over all, when entering the sick room, and to be removed when passing to their own homes. Also it would be well to fill their rooms at home with vapor of lime as a precautionary measure.

No swab or roughly irritating substance should be put into the throat of any diphtheritic patient. But all applications made to the throat and therapeutic measures should be left to an intelligent physician.

No children should be allowed to visit under any pretext whatever the afflicted ones nor to attend at the funeral of those who have died.
