BIG STRIKE IN LITTLE BELL.

Anticipated Large Body of Rich Ore Found Last Night.

PROVES EXTENSIVE AREA.

Comstock Given Good Report of Mine and Mill—California Also Discovers Promising Ore Body.

An important strike that has been anticipated for several days was made by the night shift in the Little Bell property at Park City early this morning.
