ACCOUNT OF THE "SERPENT" DISASTER.

Jay Gould is Very Confident—Some Unpleasant In London.

MURDERED HER BABY.

A Dose of Lanthanum Does the Horrible Work.

THE "SERPENT" WHICH.

Account of the Fatal Accident Caused by a Serpenter.

COMBUSTION, Nov. 16.—The evidence of the survivors of the wrecked cruiser *Serpent*, now to show the truth of the village lighthouse was not seen by the lookout on the *Serpent*, although the light is usually visible fourteen miles. It is believed that the *Serpent's* compass was affected by iron in the reef, and observations were impossible owing to the weather. A body washed ashore today, supposed to be that of the commander of the *Serpent*.

The British gunboat *Lapwing* brought the *Serpent's* survivors to Coruna today. An Associated Press correspondent boarded the *Lapwing* and had an interview with one of the survivors, named Burton. He said when the *Serpent* struck, the weather was "dirty" but not foggy. All hands were below except the officer and watchman. Immediately after the shock all rushed to the deck. A large boat was lowered and the survivors failed. Meanwhile men were being constantly washed overboard.

At about an hour after the *Serpent* struck, the captain gave the men leave to save themselves as they thought best. Burton jumped overboard, having a belt about his waist, and swam for his life. After swimming two or three hours, he landed in an exhausted condition. He then met Larza, another swimmer, and together they walked to the coast village, two miles from the scene of the wreck, whence some of the villagers conveyed them to Coruna.

Larza, who is well over 70, confirmed Burton's story. Larza was washed overboard half an hour after the shock. He had on no life belt, but after being in the water an hour and a half, managed to reach shore. Burton and Larza were the only survivors of the *Serpent*.

When the *Lapwing* left the village of eight bodies of the victims had been buried. A majority were not drowned but killed by being dashed against the rocks. Quaid, the third survivor, is very ill.
