Registered Letters and Money Orders.

REGISTRATION.—Letters may be received on payment of a fee of eight cents if the government takes no responsibility for safe carriage or compensation in case of loss.

MONEY ORDERS.—All principal post offices now receive small sums of money in the form of drafts for the same upon

post-offices, subject to the following charges and regulations:

INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS of Great Britain, Germany and Switzerland may be transmitted by the Postmaster General of New York, may be obtained on payment of the following fees, and subject to the following regulations:

LETTERS.—The standard single rate is 3 cents, to or from Montreal, Quebec, or St. Louis. To or from the United States, irrespective of distance, 6 cents; otherwise, 10 cents. To or from other British North American Provinces, for distance of not over 2,000 miles, 6 cents.

Rate of Foreign Postage
The standard single rate to Germany is half an ounce avoirdupois; to the Continent (by French mail) 3 ounces, or one-quarter ounce less. The asterisk (*) indicates that payment is optional.
