

LANDS WILL NOT BE IRRIGATED

Secretary of Interior Issues
Statement Regarding Land
Under "Fourth Lift."

HOMESTEAD LAW APPLIES.

Upon Recommendation of Reclamation
Service Big Tract to be
Opened for Settlement.

Washington, D. C., Nov. 2.—A grave misapprehension has arisen regarding the character of lands near the Minidoka project, Cassia county, Idaho, which were recently restored to entry by the secretary of the interior.

The lands were restored because no plans are being made to irrigate this area. Any entry made upon the supposition that these lands would be under what is known as the "Fourth Lift" of the Minidoka project, is founded on an absolute misunderstanding, because construction of the fourth lift has been definitely abandoned.

Those who have made homestead entry on the area restored must live upon the land, cultivate and improve it in accordance with the terms of the homestead law and have no reasonable ground to anticipate that water will ever be furnished for irrigation.

Homestead entrants who took these lands in the hope that the operation of the reclamation service will enable them to comply with the homestead law are doing so on an entirely unfounded supposition, and they must necessarily perfect their entries without the assistance of any water supply from the Minidoka project.

RESTORED FOR ENTRY.

Approximately 544,000 acres of land which were withdrawn in connection with the Dubois irrigation project, Idaho, have been restored to the public domain by the secretary of the interior. The area is involved in a segregation of lands to be included in a Carey act project under the application of the state of Idaho. The restoration covers lands in townships 5 to 19 north, ranges 28 to 40 east.

This action was taken by the department for the reason that there will not be available from the reclamation fund for some years the money necessary for the development of the project, and upon the petition of the governor and the state land board of the state of Idaho, the secretary of the interior decided to withdraw from the project, if the state found it practicable to take it up under the Carey act.

The restoration became effective in such a manner as to protect the segregation made upon the request of the state.

SUBJECT TO SETTLEMENT.

The secretary of the interior has restored to entry the following described lands in Idaho upon recommendation of the reclamation service, as being no longer necessary to the interests of the Payette-Biose project: Township 23 south, range 46 east, all section 15, southeast quarter of section 16; east half of section 21; all section 22; northwest quarter section 27; all sections 28 and 29.

Township 24 south, range 46 east, north half of section 4; west half of section 5; all section 6 and north half of section 7.

These lands will become subject to settlement and entry upon such dates and after such notice and publication as the secretary of the interior may prescribe.

RED CROSS STAMPS.

The American Red Cross, whose Christmas stamps are a familiar feature of the holiday season in every community of the United States, is the greatest relief organization in the world. Since its reorganization under a special act of Congress, in January, 1901, the Red Cross has expended an average of more than \$1,000,000 a year in relief operations. The foundation upon which this great organization is established is found in the charter given by act of Congress which, in defining the purpose of the Red Cross, says: "To furnish voluntary aid to the sick and wounded of armies in time of war," and "To carry on a system of national and international relief in time of peace, and apply the same in mitigating the sufferings caused by pestilence, famine, fire, floods, and other great national calamities, and to devise and carry out measures for preventing the same."

It will be noted that Congress intended that the Red Cross should not confine itself to the relief of suffering caused by calamity but that it should devise and carry out measures for preventing calamity as far as practicable. It is under this provision of its charter that the organization is undertaking its fight against tuberculosis.
